Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

Today, we come to the culmination of the most sacred week of the year. During Holy Week, we celebrated the passion and death of Jesus Christ. Today we celebrate his resurrection. We celebrate that He Is Risen!

Saturday evening, we gathered to begin our vigil. As we kept watch for his resurrection, we listened to the words of Scripture as we relived salvation history. In today's gospel, we are confronted with the empty tomb. The disciples have not yet seen the risen Christ, they do not know where he is, but as they entered the empty tomb, they "saw and believed." Although they believed, "they did not yet understand the Scriptures that he had to rise from the dead." (Jn 20:9)

There may be times when we do not understand our faith. Understanding is not necessary for belief. If we put our faith in Christ, understanding will follow. Without faith, Christ's sacrifice is beyond understanding.

Construction Update

Last Saturday, because the church was not ready for Mass, we had the evening Mass in the Activity Center gym.

Immediately following the 4:00 Mass, volunteers went to work setting up the church for Sunday. While they were still laying down carpet near the Third Street entrance and in the West transept of the church, volunteers were setting up chairs in the East transept and in the main body of the church. While all this was going on, the cleaning crew came in and vacuumed and dusted and then vacuumed and dusted some more. The last of the carpet was glued down at about 8 PM. The cleaning crew was there until 9 PM. They did an incredible job. I am not sure that I would have believed it on Saturday morning, but the church was ready for Mass on Sunday. Thank you to everyone who worked so hard to make ready for Mass!

Divine Mercy Sunday

Sunday, April 24th, the Second Sunday of Easter, is Divine Mercy Sunday. In the 1930s, our Lord appeared to St. Faustina and asked her to spread the message of his Divine Mercy throughout the world, the message that God's mercy is greater than our sin. We join in that message.

On Sunday, the image of the Divine Mercy will be available for veneration at both St. Mary and St. Richard churches, and we will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy following Mass.

Those who take part in these devotions to the Divine Mercy, with a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for sin and who also fulfill the usual conditions, will receive a plenary indulgence. The requirements to receive a plenary indulgence, in addition to performing the act (as stated above), are: 1) Go to sacramental confession within 20 days before or after the act. 2) Receive the Holy Communion, preferably on the day of, or the day before or after the act. 3) Pray for the intentions of the Pope.

Pamphlets are available in the church for those who would like to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy or those who would like to make the complete Novena to the Divine Mercy.
