# Notes from Fr. Sean

#### In Today's Gospel

Happy Easter! Today we continue our celebration of the Octave of Easter. In today's gospel, Christ appears to his disciples both on the first day of the octave, Easter Sunday, and the eighth day of the octave, the following Sunday. I can only imagine the mix of emotions the disciples felt. The grief at having lost Jesus, the fear that they might suffer the same fate, the shock of the empty tomb, and the confusion at the stories that were beginning to be heard that Christ had been seen alive. Amid this anxiety, Jesus greets his disciples with the words, "Peace be with you."

We, too, are in a time of confusion and anxiety. The pandemic lingers on. There is war in Africa, Europe, the Middle East, and more. Prices are getting higher and higher. In this anxiety, Christ says to us, "Peace be with you." If we put our faith in Christ, the wars may not end, people will still die from COVID-19, and inflation will still increase, but we can have peace. We can be at peace knowing that our loving Savior has paid the price for our sins and has come to show us the way to everlasting peace, in heaven.

#### **Thank You**

For the last couple of months, I have been keeping you up-to-date on the progress of the floor project at St. Mary. Today, that project is almost complete. We still have some molding to install around the new ramp, and we need to have our handrails installed, but we are almost there. This project has transformed the look of the church at St. Mary. The carpet that had become a trip hazard is gone. The new ramp to the altar makes it accessible to anyone with mobility issues. The floor is more stable.

The original project, planned before the pandemic, called for tile throughout the church. Due to the financial difficulties brought on by the pandemic, this is no longer possible. Most of the money that we had set aside for the floor project, money that St. Mary received from the estate of a former parishioner, went to other necessary building repairs and to help keep us afloat during the pandemic.

When we were planning to do tile, our architect told us that, due to the weight of the tile, it would be necessary to add additional support to the central aisle. When we opted to go with just carpet, we considered eliminating this additional support, but we decided to continue because it would give us options in the future.

Before we began, we knew that there were problems with the original floor. We did not know the extent of the problems until the work started. In the end, we had to add even more support to the floor, which is now in better shape than it has been since that portion of the church was built in 1923.

This project would not have been possible without generous donations from the friends of St. Mary. When we began planning this project, both the St. Mary Café, and Trivia Night dedicated their fundraising to this project. Without your dedication to St. Mary, we could not have completed this project as we did. The majority of the funding for this project was provided by Glenn Shaw, and the Shaw Family Foundation. Not only did Mr. Shaw provide much of the funding for the project, but he also helped us secure contractors who went above and beyond to make this project a success. Thank you to everyone who made this project possible.


