

Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

The image of the vineyard we see in today's gospel was not the new image to the people of Israel. We see the same image used in our first reading today from the prophet Isaiah. Through the prophet Isaiah, God tells us that "The vineyard of the LORD of hosts is the house of Israel, the people of Judah, his cherished plant." (Is 7:7a) This image of the vineyard as the people of God extends to us today.

In the reading from Isaiah, the vineyard was neglected by those responsible for its care. In the Gospel, those responsible for the care of the vineyard took advantage of their position. They rejected the master, putting his servants and even his son to death. We are all responsible for caring for the vineyard of the Lord, each in our own way. Let us not neglect our duties as we welcome the Son when he comes.

La imagen de la viña que vemos en el evangelio de hoy no era la nueva imagen para el pueblo de Israel. Vemos la misma imagen utilizada en nuestra primera lectura de hoy del profeta Isaías. A través del profeta Isaías, Dios nos dice que "La viña de Jehová de los ejércitos es la casa de Israel, el pueblo de Judá, su planta preciada". (Is 7:7a) Esta imagen de la viña como pueblo de Dios se extiende hasta nosotros hoy.

En la lectura de Isaías, la viña fue descuidada por los responsables de su cuidado. En el Evangelio, los responsables del cuidado de la viña se aprovecharon de su posición. Rechazaron al amo, dando muerte a sus sirvientes e incluso a su hijo. Todos somos responsables de cuidar la viña del Señor, cada uno a nuestra manera. No descuidemos nuestros deberes al acoger al Hijo cuando venga.

First Communion

Today, we celebrate with our second-grade faith formation students as they begin their journey to join us around the altar of Christ. Second grade is an exciting year in faith formation. This is the year that they will receive not one but two sacraments for the first time. In January, they will receive the sacrament of reconciliation for the first time as they prepare for their first Communion in May.

Reconciliation with God is the first step to communion. We must all recognize that we are sinners and that our sin breaks our communion with God. In the sacrament of reconciliation, we seek to restore that communion. We should all make regular use of the sacrament of reconciliation. Through this sacrament, God gives us the grace to help us to overcome sin in our lives. At St. Mary, the sacrament of reconciliation is offered every Saturday at 3 PM. At St. Richard, reconciliation is offered every Tuesday morning following Mass; at 9:45 AM. During the seasons of Advent and Lent, we have special penance services available, with multiple priests available to hear your confessions. In addition, you can contact the parish office to schedule a time for confession that is more convenient for your schedule.

Today, our second graders will begin their journey to reconciliation in communion. Together, let us pray for them as we look forward to them joining us at the altar of Christ.

En St. Mary, el sacramento de la reconciliación se ofrece todos los sábados a las 3 p.m. En St. Richard, la reconciliación se ofrece todos los martes por la mañana después de la misa; a las 9:45 a.m. Durante las temporadas de Adviento y Cuaresma, tenemos disponibles servicios especiales de penitencia, con varios sacerdotes disponibles para escuchar sus confesiones. Además, puede comunicarse con la oficina parroquial para programar un horario de confesión que sea más conveniente para su horario.

Hoy, nuestros alumnos de segundo grado comenzarán su camino hacia la reconciliación en comunión. Juntos, oremos por ellos mientras esperamos que se unan a nosotros en el altar de Cristo.
