Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

We have listened to Jesus teaching and telling parables for the last few weeks. While the Jewish people have welcomed him to Jerusalem as the "Son of David," the Jewish authorities are looking for an excuse to have him arrested.

In today's gospel, they set a trap for Jesus by asking him about paying the Roman tax. Jesus demonstrates their hypocrisy when he asks for a Roman coin. One of the priests hands him a coin with the image of Caesar on it and an inscription declaring the divinity of Caesar. Remember, all of this takes place in the temple, and the reason for the money changers was because it was forbidden to use Roman coins in the temple.

Jesus tells them to "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." (Mt 22:21) The Roman coin, which contains the image of Caesar, belongs to Caesar. We are made in the image and likeness of God (Gn 1:26), and therefore we belong to God.

En el evangelio de hoy

Hemos escuchado a Jesús enseñando y contando parábolas durante las últimas semanas. Mientras el pueblo judío lo ha recibido en Jerusalén como el "Hijo de David", las autoridades judías buscan una excusa para arrestarlo.

En el evangelio de hoy, le pusieron una trampa a Jesús preguntándole sobre el pago del impuesto romano. Jesús demuestra su hipocresía cuando pide una moneda romana. Uno de los sacerdotes le entrega una moneda con la imagen de César y una inscripción que declara la divinidad de César. Recuerde, todo esto ocurre en el templo, y la razón de los cambistas fue porque estaba prohibido usar monedas romanas en el templo.

Jesús les dice: "Paguén al César lo que es del César y a Dios lo que es de Dios". (Mt 22:21) La moneda romana, que contiene la imagen del César, pertenece al César. Estamos hechos a imagen y semejanza de Dios (Gn 1,26), y por tanto pertenecemos a Dios.

Nankin Family of Parishes

Last week, the Family Leadership Team (FLT) and the Family Pastoral Council (FPC) for our family met to begin to chart our course moving forward. These groups are responsible for coordinating the activities of our Family Parishes.

The first task before the FLT and the FPC is to help determine how our four parishes' needs can be met with two priests. It will be necessary to make some changes, especially when it comes to Mass times. Even when we had been a three priests family, we recognized that our weekday Mass schedule was excessive and repetitive. On some days, we have one Mass, and on others, we have three Masses, often with two or three at the same time. On weekends, we have four Masses on Saturday and eight Masses on Sunday.

In the coming weeks, we will have to make adjustments to our Mass schedule for both weekdays and weekends. Please be patient. We are working to serve the needs of all of the people in our family parishes.

En las próximas semanas tendremos que hacer ajustes en nuestro horario de misas tanto entre semana como los fines de semana. Por favor sea paciente. Estamos trabajando para atender las necesidades de todas las personas en nuestras parroquias familiares.




