### Notes from Fr. Sean

#### In Today's Gospel

John the Baptist came to testify to the light, to Jesus Christ. In today's gospel, he tells us that he is "the voice of one crying out in the desert, 'make straight the way of the Lord'" (Jn 1:23) John warned the Pharisees, and he warns us that "there is one among you whom you do not recognize, the one who is coming after me." (Jn 1:26) Let us follow John's example of humility and prepare our hearts to recognize and to receive Christ.

#### En el Evangelio de Hoy

Juan el Bautista vino a dar testimonio de la luz, de Jesucristo. En el evangelio de hoy, nos dice que él es "la voz del que clama en el desierto: 'Enderezad el camino del Señor'" (Jn 1,23) Juan advirtió a los fariseos, y nos advierte a nosotros de que "hay uno entre vosotros al que no reconocéis, el que viene detrás de mí". (Jn 1, 26) Sigamos el ejemplo de humildad de Juan y preparemos nuestros corazones para reconocer y recibir a Cristo.

#### A Season of Penance

Christmas is almost here. Between the parties and last-minute Christmas shopping, do not neglect the most important preparation we need to make before we celebrate the arrival of Christ. We must prepare our hearts. Although we think of Christmas as a festive season, and it is, Advent is a season of penance and preparation.

John the Baptist was sent by God to "Prepare the way of the Lord, to make straight his paths." (Mk 1:3). How did John fulfill his mission? John fulfilled his mission by "proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins." (Mk 1:4)

Repentance from sin is necessary to prepare the way for the Lord. Just as John called the people of Judea to repent from their sins, we are also called to repent from our sins as we prepare to for Christmas.

Throughout the season of Advent, there are many opportunities to receive the sacrament of reconciliation. In addition to our regularly scheduled confessions (Tuesday mornings at 9:45 AM at St. Richard and Saturday afternoons at 3 PM at St. Mary, Wayne, and 6:30 PM at St. Mary, Cause of Our Joy), we will have two penance services for the Nankin Family of Parishes. This week, there will be penance services on Tuesday at 7 PM at St. Mary in Wayne and 1 PM on Wednesday at St. Thomas the Apostle. Please take this opportunity, or one of the opportunities in our neighboring parishes, to confess your sins and prepare the way of the Lord in your heart.

#### Tiempo de Penitencia

La Navidad está casi aquí. Entre las fiestas y las compras navideñas de última hora, no descuidemos la preparación más importante que debemos hacer antes de celebrar la llegada de Cristo. Debemos preparar nuestro corazón. Aunque pensamos en la Navidad como una época festiva, y lo es, el Adviento es un tiempo de penitencia y preparación.

Juan el Bautista fue enviado por Dios para "Preparar el camino del Señor, para enderezar sus sendas". (Mc 1,3). ¿Cómo cumplió Juan su misión? Juan cumplió su misión "proclamando un bautismo de conversión para el perdón de los pecados." (Mc 1,4)

El arrepentimiento del pecado es necesario para preparar el camino al Señor. Al igual que Juan llamó al pueblo de Judea a arrepentirse de sus pecados, nosotros también estamos llamados a arrepentirnos de nuestros pecados mientras nos preparamos para la Navidad.

A lo largo del tiempo de Adviento, hay muchas oportunidades para recibir el sacramento de la reconciliación. Además de nuestras confesiones programadas regularmente (martes por la mañana a las 9:45 AM en St. Richard y los sábados por la tarde a las 3 PM en St. Mary, Wayne, y 6:30 PM en St. Mary, Causa de Nuestra Alegría), tendremos dos servicios de penitencia para la Familia Nankin de Parroquias. Esta semana, habrá confesiones el martes a las 7 PM en Santa María en Wayne y el miércoles a la 1 PM en Santo Tomás Apóstol. Por favor aprovechen esta oportunidad, o una de las oportunidades en nuestras parroquias vecinas, para confesar sus pecados y preparar el camino del Señor en su corazón.
