Last week, Jesus gave us a call to action. He told us that we are to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world. In today's gospel, he begins to tell us what that means.

When Jesus says, "You have heard that was said... But I say to you," he is calling us to a higher standard of morality. Too often today, we try to find a way around God's law; to conform God to our will. That is a consequence of our fallen nature. We must resist that urge. We must seek to conform our will to the will of God.

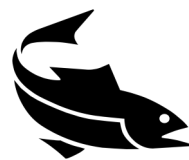

From CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH**•ARTICLE 10**

The forgiveness of sins.

Christ came to save the world from sin. Belief in the forgiveness of sins is essential to Christianity. Catholicism believes sins are forgiven in Baptism and in the Sacrament of Penance.

•ARTICLE 11

The resurrection of the body.

From the Catholic perspective, a human being is a union of body and soul. Hence, death is just the momentary separation of body and soul until the end of the world, the Second Coming of Christ, the General Judgment, and the resurrection of the dead and some body and soul go into heaven, and the damned body and soul go into hell.

•ARTICLE 12

And in life everlasting.

As Christ Our Savior died, so, too, must mere mortals. As he rose, so shall all human beings. Death is the only way to cross from this life into the next. Private judgment occurs at the very moment of death; Christ judges the soul.

****On the 3rd article, we should bow our heads, as prescribed by the rubric of the Missal, to honor the Incarnation of our Lord (On Annunciation and Christmas, we genuflect instead of bowing).**
