(Mt 5:55) It's easy to love those who love us, but to be truly Christlike, we must seek to love those who are difficult to love.

Ash Wednesday

Throughout Scripture, ashes are used as a sign of penance. Jeremiah instructs the people to "dress in sackcloth, roll in the ashes. Mourn as for an only child." (6:26) When Jesus confronts those who had seen his deeds but had not repented, he says that Tyre and Sidon "would long ago have repented in sackcloth and ashes," if they had seen those mighty deeds. (Mt 11:21)

This Wednesday, we begin Lent. Although Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation, there will be several opportunities to attend Mass or prayer services and receive ashes. There will be a Mass at 9 AM at St. Mary and St. Richard and a 7 PM Mass at St. Mary. There will also be Scripture services, with ashes, at St. Mary at 12:30 and St. Richard at 7 PM.

Miércoles de Ceniza

The first is joining our parishes in prayer every day at 7:07 PM. Wherever you are, join us in saying 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary, and 1 Glory Be. While we are free to add our own intentions to this prayer, our communal intention is for an increase in vocations to the priesthood.

A second way we can enter into prayer is by reading Scripture. I invite you to join us in our Lent/Easter Scripture Challenge. This year, we will read the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles. Reading guides will be available in the church and online. If you need a Bible, please contact the parish office.



Stations of the Cross



For Roman Catholics throughout the world, the Stations of the Cross are synonymous with Lent, Holy Week and, especially, Good Friday. This devotion is also known as the "Way of the Cross," the "Via Crucis", and the "Via Dolorosa."

It commemorates 14 key events on the day of Christ's crucifixion. The Stations originated in medieval Europe when wars prevented Christian pilgrims from visiting the Holy Land. In the 12th century, St Francis of Assisi devised the list of stations and started the tradition of reciting it as a type of devotional service. Please join us at St. Mary every Friday at 6:30 pm in English and 7 pm in lengua Española (Spanish) to pray at Stations of Cross. In addition, we will walk and meditate on Jesus' Calvary at St. Richard every Tuesday at 12 pm.

Praying the "Stations of the Cross" is one of the most popular devotions for Roman Catholics and is often performed in a spirit of reparation for the sufferings and insults that Jesus endured during His Passion. The object of the Stations of the Cross is to help us make a spiritual pilgrimage of prayer through meditating upon the chief scenes of Christ's sufferings and death. A plenary indulgence may be gained by praying the Stations of the Cross.


