### Notes from Fr. Sean

#### In Today's Gospel

This is our last week with the Sermon on the Mount for a while. In today's gospel, Jesus continues to challenge us. He challenges us to love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us. (Mt 5:55) It's easy to love those who love us, but to be truly Christlike, we must seek to love those who are difficult to love.

#### En el Evangelio de Hoy

Esta es nuestra última semana con el Sermón del Monte por un tiempo. En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús continúa desafiándonos. Nos desafía a amar a nuestros enemigos ya orar por los que nos persiguen. (Mt 5:55) Es fácil amar a los que nos aman, pero para ser verdaderamente como Cristo, debemos buscar amar a los que son difíciles de amar.

#### Ash Wednesday

Throughout Scripture, ashes are used as a sign of penance. Jeremiah instructs the people to "dress in sackcloth, roll in the ashes. Mourn as for an only child." (6:26) When Jesus confronts those who had seen his deeds but had not repented, he says that Tyre and Sidon "would long ago have repented in sackcloth and ashes," if they had seen those mighty deeds. (Mt 11:21)

This Wednesday, we begin Lent. Although Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation, there will be several opportunities to attend Mass or prayer services and receive ashes. There will be a Mass at 9 AM at St. Mary and St. Richard and a 7 PM Mass at St. Mary. There will also be Scripture services, with ashes, at St. Mary at 12:30 and St. Richard at 7 PM.

#### Miércoles de Ceniza

A lo largo de las Escrituras, las cenizas se usan como señal de penitencia. Jeremías instruye al pueblo a "vestirse de cilicio, revolcarse en la ceniza. Llorad como por un hijo único". (6:26) Cuando Jesús confronta a aquellos que habían visto sus obras pero no se habían arrepentido, dice que Tiro y Sidón "hace mucho tiempo que se habrían arrepentido en cilicio y ceniza", si hubieran visto esas obras poderosas. (Mt 11,21)

Este miércoles comenzamos la Cuaresma. Aunque el Miércoles de Ceniza no es un día santo de precepto, habrá varias oportunidades para asistir a misa o servicios de oración y recibir cenizas. Habrá una misa a las 9 am en St. Mary y St. Richard y una misa a las 7 pm en St. Mary. También habrá servicios bíblicos, con cenizas, en St. Mary a las 12:30 y en St. Richard a las 7:00 p. m.

#### Let Us Pray

During Lent, we are called to increase our prayer. There are many ways that we can do that. There are two that I would like to encourage. The first is joining our parishes in prayer every day at 7:07 PM. Wherever you are, join us in saying 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary, and 1 Glory Be. While we are free to add our own intentions to this prayer, our communal intention is for an increase in vocations to the priesthood.

A second way we can enter into prayer is by reading Scripture. I invite you to join us in our Lent/Easter Scripture Challenge. This year, we will read the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles. Reading guides will be available in the church and online. If you need a Bible, please contact the parish office.

#### Oremos

**Stations of the Cross**



For Roman Catholics throughout the world, the Stations of the Cross are synonymous with Lent, Holy Week and, especially, Good Friday. This devotion is also known as the "Way of the Cross," the "Via Crucis", and the "Via Dolorosa."

It commemorates 14 key events on the day of Christ's crucifixion. The Stations originated in medieval Europe when wars prevented Christian pilgrims from visiting the Holy Land. In the 12th century, St. Francis of Assisi devised the list of stations and started the tradition of reciting it as a type of devotional service. Please join us at St. Mary every Friday at 6:30 pm in English and 7 pm in lengua Española (Spanish) to pray at Stations of Cross. In addition, we will walk and meditate on Jesus' Calvary at St. Richard every Tuesday at 12 pm.

Praying the "Stations of the Cross" is one of the most popular devotions for Roman Catholics and is often performed in a spirit of reparation for the sufferings and insults that Jesus endured during His Passion. The object of the Stations of the Cross is to help us make a spiritual pilgrimage of prayer through meditating upon the chief scenes of Christ's sufferings and death. A plenary indulgence may be gained by praying the Stations of the Cross.
