**Notes from Fr. Sean**

**In Today's Gospel**

Today, we begin the most sacred week of the year, Holy Week. In today's gospel, we will see the crowds welcome Jesus into Jerusalem, crying out, "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord" (Mt 21:9) only to cry out a few days later "Let him be crucified." (Mt 27: 22)

As we reflect on these Gospels, let us put ourselves into the crowd. Will we welcome Jesus on Palm Sunday only to reject him on Good Friday? Will we mock him by calling him our king as we spit on him? Will we run and hide as most of the apostles did, or will we stand with him as the women did? Let us "watch and pray that [we] may not undergo the test." (Mt 26:41)

**En el evangelio de hoy**

Hoy comenzamos la semana más sagrada del año, la Semana Santa. "Velen y oren, para que no [caigamos] en tentación". (Mt 26,41)

**Holy Week**

Holy Week is a busy week in the Church. On Holy Thursday, we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at St. Mary at 7 PM. This marks the end of Lent and the beginning of the Easter Triduum. Soup for Supper will be served by our Youth Group beginning at 5:30 PM. All are welcome. Following Mass, there will be a procession to the Garden Altar of Repose, where we will keep watch with Christ.

On Good Friday, we do not celebrate Mass. Stations of the Cross will begin at noon, and the Good Friday service, with Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion, starts at 1 PM at both parishes.

On Holy Saturday, we keep watch for the resurrection of Christ. Our Mass begins after sunset, at 8:30 PM, at St. Mary. We have five people receiving the sacrament of confirmation this year. This Mass runs a little long, but it is worth it.

On Sunday, we will have our regular Sunday Masses as we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
