

THE RESURRECTION OF THE *Lord* LA RESURRECCIÓN DEL *Señor*

Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

"Do not be afraid!" These are the words that Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were greeted with in today's gospel when they found the empty tomb. Mary Magdalene showed great courage in going to the tomb that Sunday morning. She was one of the few who remained with Jesus during his crucifixion. Because of her faithfulness, and her courage, Mary Magdalene was the first to encounter the risen Christ, the first to announce to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord." (Jn 20:18) When we are confronted with the empty tomb, do not be afraid. We know that our Lord has risen and has gone before us. Let us follow him from death to new life, eternal life in heaven.

En el Evangelio de Hoy

"¡No tengas miedo!" Estas son las palabras con las que María Magdalena y la otra María fueron recibidas en el evangelio de hoy cuando encontraron el sepulcro vacío. María Magdalena mostró gran valentía al ir al sepulcro ese domingo por la mañana. Ella fue una de las pocas que permaneció con Jesús durante su crucifixión. Por su fidelidad y su valentía, María Magdalena fue la primera en encontrarse con Cristo resucitado, la primera en anunciar a los discípulos: "He visto al Señor". (Juan 20:18) Cuando nos enfrentemos a la tumba vacía, no tengáis miedo. Sabemos que nuestro Señor ha resucitado y nos ha precedido. Sigámoslo de la muerte a la vida nueva, la vida eterna en el cielo.

He is risen! He is risen, indeed!

When Jesus appeared to the disciples on the road to Emmaus that first Easter Sunday, they did not recognize him. At supper, when he took the bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to them, their eyes were opened. They recognized the risen Lord. They immediately returned to Jerusalem with news of what they had seen and were greeted with the news that "the Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" (Lk 24:34 RSV) This gives us our familiar Easter greeting: "He is risen! He is risen, indeed!"

The resurrection of Jesus is not simply a historical event that happened 2,000 years ago. When he rose from the dead, Jesus destroyed sin and death. He has risen, and will die no more.

Jesus' resurrection is not the end of the Easter story; it is the beginning. Jesus died for our sins. In his resurrection, he gives us new life, eternal life. He is risen indeed!

¡Él ha resucitado!

Cuando Jesús se apareció a los discípulos en el camino a Emaús ese primer domingo de Pascua, no lo reconocieron. En la cena, cuando tomó el pan, lo bendijo, lo partió y se lo dio, se les abrieron los ojos. Reconocieron al Señor resucitado. Inmediatamente regresaron a Jerusalén con la noticia de lo que habían visto y fueron recibidos con la noticia de que "¡El Señor ha resucitado y se ha aparecido a Simón!". (Lc 24,34) Esto nos da nuestro familiar saludo pascual: "¡Él ha resucitado!"

La resurrección de Jesús no es simplemente un evento histórico que sucedió hace 2000 años. Cuando resucitó de entre los muertos, Jesús destruyó el pecado y la muerte. Ha resucitado, y no morirá más.

La resurrección de Jesús no es el final de la historia de la Pascua; es el principio Jesús murió por nuestros pecados. En su resurrección, nos da vida nueva, vida eterna. ¡Él ha resucitado!

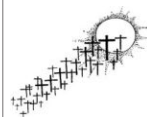
