Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

The news of Jesus' resurrection quickly began to spread beyond Jerusalem. Although many of his disciples hid in fear, others had to go about their lives. In today's gospel, two of those disciples encountered Jesus on their way to Emmaus, although they did not recognize him.

Caught up in their fear, sadness, and confusion, they are not yet ready to see him. Jesus accompanies them on their journey. Only when their hearts have calmed do they recognize him in the breaking of the bread.

Jesus walks with us as well. Although there are times when we cannot see him, when we do not sense his presence, he is with us always. In our pain, in our sadness, in our confusion, let us turn to him, and he will comfort us.

He will bring that experience with him into his ministry. I know that much greater things are in store for him as he prepares to serve the people of God as a priest.

This year, the Archdiocese of Detroit will ordain five new priests. This will be a great blessing, but it does not begin to replace the priests retiring this year. God calls plenty of men to be priests; they just have to respond to that call. Please pray for all men considering the priesthood while we pray for Deacon Sean as he begins this new chapter in his life.
