In Today's Gospel

Catholic Services Appeal

We are all called to announce the Gospel of the Lord in our families, in our communities, and in the world. One of the ways we do this is through the missionary work of the church. In the Archdiocese of Detroit (AOD) we support the missionary activity of the Church in Southeast Michigan through the Catholic Services Appeal (CSA). Most of you have already received your pledge cards in the mail. Through CSA, we support spreading the gospel within our communities.

Our CSA goals for 2023 are \$68,007 for St. Mary and \$15,271 for St. Richard. At St. Richard, we are still fundraising to replace the roof of our church, which we hope to do in the coming fall or spring. For that reason, we have increased our parish goal to \$65,271.

All donations received that exceed the goal set by the AOD are returned to the parish. By generously supporting CSA, we not only support the missionary work of the Church, but we support our own parishes. The most effective way to support our parish is to donate to CSA.

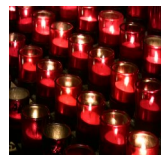

The Story Behind the Feast of Corpus Christi

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, historically known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. It is traditionally celebrated on Thursday following the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. The feast dates to the Middle Ages and originated with a visionary nun and a Eucharistic miracle.

In 1263 a German priest, Fr. Peter of Prague, made a pilgrimage to Rome. He stopped in Bolsena, Italy, to celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Christina. At the time, he had doubts about Jesus being truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. He was affected by the growing debate among certain theologians who, for the first time in the history of the Church, began introducing doubts about the Body and Blood of Christ being present in the consecrated bread and wine. In response to his doubt, when he recited the prayer of consecration as he celebrated the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, blood started seeping from the consecrated host onto the altar and corporal. Fr. Peter reported this miracle to Pope Urban IV, who was nearby in Orvieto. The pope sent delegates to investigate and ordered that host and blood-stained corporal be brought to Orvieto. The relics were placed in the Cathedral of Orvieto, where they remain.

This Eucharistic Miracle confirmed the visions given to St. Juliana of Mont Cornillon in Belgium (1193-1258). St. Juliana was a nun and mystic who had a series of visions in which Our Lord instructed her to work to establish a liturgical feast for the Holy Eucharist, to which she had great devotion.

After many years of trying, she convinced the future Pope Urban IV to create this feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament, where none had existed. Soon after her death, Pope Urban instituted Corpus Christi for the Universal Church. He celebrated it for the first time in Orvieto in 1264, a year after the Eucharistic Miracle in Bolsena.

Inspired by the miracle, Pope Urban commissioned a Dominican friar, St. Thomas Aquinas, to compose the Mass for the feast of Corpus Christi. Aquinas' hymns in honor of the Holy Eucharist, Pange Lingua, Tantum Ergo, Panis Angelicus, and O Salutaris Hostia are the beloved hymns the Church sings on the feast of Corpus Christi as well as throughout the year during Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

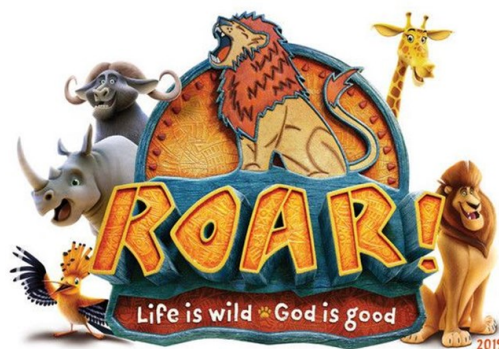
