Room Rentals

At St. Mary, we have a great deal of space. Since we closed our school, I have been reluctant to rent out rooms in the hopes of getting a charter school. I did not want to start something only to have to cancel it if we got a charter. In the last five years, we have had three good possibilities for finding a charter school; unfortunately, they have all fallen through.

Recently the Facilities Use Committee polled the parishioners, and after discussing it with the Finance Council, we recognize that there is not enough interest in pursuing a charter school. That opens the possibility of allowing our facilities to be rented for special events. The Facilities Use Committee is now working to establish policies and procedures for rentals. In the meantime, we will begin to allow the use of our facilities for funeral luncheons. At this time, we can only provide the space. If you would like to host a funeral luncheon, you will have to provide a caterer.

Alquiler de habitaciones

En St. Mary, tenemos una gran cantidad de espacio. Desde que cerramos nuestra escuela, he sido reacio a alquilar habitaciones con la esperanza de conseguir una escuela autónoma. No quería comenzar algo solo para tener que cancelarlo si conseguíamos una carta. En los últimos cinco años, hemos tenido tres buenas posibilidades para encontrar una escuela charter; desafortunadamente, todos han fracasado.

Recientemente, el Comité de Uso de Instalaciones encuestó a los feligreses y, después de discutirlo con el Consejo de Finanzas, reconocemos que no hay suficiente interés en buscar una escuela charter. Eso abre la posibilidad de permitir que nuestras instalaciones sean alquiladas para eventos especiales. El Comité de Uso de Instalaciones ahora está trabajando para establecer políticas y procedimientos para alquileres. Mientras tanto, comenzaremos a permitir el uso de nuestras instalaciones para almuerzos fúnebres. En este momento, solo podemos proporcionar el espacio. Si desea organizar un almuerzo fúnebre, deberá proporcionar un servicio de catering.

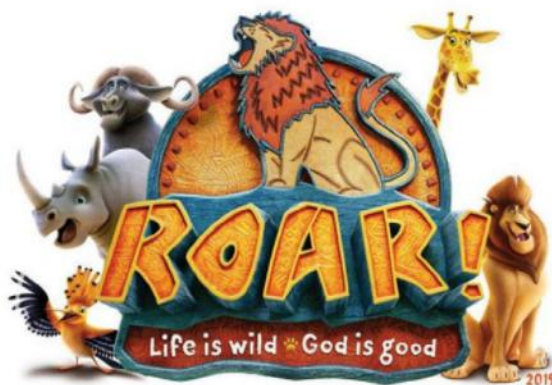
