CSA Update

St Mary and St. Richard are both making good progress in reaching our CSA goals. As I write this article, St Mary has received pledges totaling \$25,035, or 37% of our goal. St. Richard has received pledges totaling \$10,980, or 72% of our goal from the AOD. However, because we are raising money for a new roof on the church, we have increased our parish goal by \$50,000. Currently, St. Richard has reached 17% of our parish goal. CSA is the most efficient way to donate to our parishes. We are required to meet our CSA goal. If we do not, we are billed for the difference, but once we reach our goal, all donations received above that goal are returned directly to the parish. Thank you for your generosity.

St. Mary y St. Richard están haciendo un buen progreso para alcanzar nuestras metas de CSA. Mientras escribo este artículo, St. Mary recibió promesas por un total de \$25,035, o el 37% de nuestra meta. St. Richard había recibido promesas por un total de \$10,980, o el 72% de nuestra meta de AOD. Sin embargo, debido a que estamos recaudando dinero para un techo nuevo en la iglesia, hemos aumentado nuestra meta parroquial en \$50,000. Actualmente, St. Richard ha alcanzado el 17% de nuestra meta parroquial. CSA es la forma más eficiente de donar a nuestras parroquias. Estamos obligados a cumplir con nuestra meta de CSA, si no lo hacemos, se nos cobra la diferencia, pero una vez que alcanzamos nuestra meta, todas las donaciones recibidas por encima de esa meta se devuelven directamente a la parroquia. Gracias por tu generosidad.

Vacation Bible School Supplies Needed

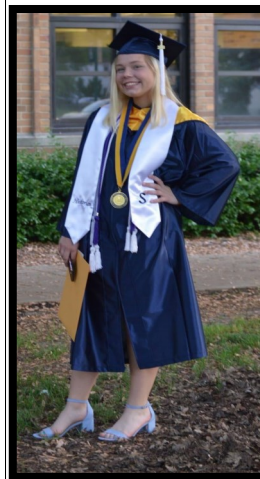
