Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

Depending on your translation, the word "pity" in today's gospel can also be translated as "mercy" or "compassion." It was God's mercy and compassion that compelled Jesus to enter into his own creation to bring us salvation. Jesus' pity for the people is born of his love for us and is given expression in his mercy. Just as Jesus sent the apostles to proclaim the good news, we are all called to announce the Gospel of the Lord and to proclaim his love.

Catholic Services Appeal

So far, both St. Mary and St. Richard are making great progress in reaching our CSA goals. St. Richard has received pledges totaling more than \$16,130. This puts us past our goal set by the Archdiocese and well on our way to paying for the new roof on the church. Thank you for your commitment to St. Richard.

At St. Mary, we received more than \$30,055 in pledges to CSA, which puts us at 44% of our goal for 2023. We are well on our way to reaching our goal. Thank you for your generosity.

CSA funds many programs in the Archdiocese of Detroit. One program that affects many people is the Metropolitan Marriage Tribunal. If you have already received a divorce, before you can get married in the Catholic Church, your first marriage must be evaluated to determine its validity and if you are free to marry. This is commonly referred to as an annulment. This can take anywhere from two weeks to more than two years, depending on the circumstances. I do not know how much this process costs because the AOD never asks people to pay for their annulments.

Many years ago, it was decided that we did not want lack of money to be the reason someone does not seek an annulment. For this reason, the Archdiocese decided that the annulment process would be funded through the CSA. Through your contributions to CSA, you are helping to support our brothers and sisters who are seeking healing through the annulment process, and you are supporting the sacrament of marriage.

Llamado al Servicio Católico (CSA)

Hasta ahora, tanto St. Mary como St. Richard están logrando un gran progreso para alcanzar nuestras metas de CSA. St. Richard ha recibido promesas por un total de más de \$16,130. Esto nos coloca más allá de nuestra meta establecida por la Arquidiócesis y en camino a pagar el nuevo techo de la iglesia. Gracias por su compromiso con St. Richard.

En St. Mary, recibimos más de \$30,055 en promesas para CSA, lo que nos coloca en el 44 % de nuestra meta para 2023. Estamos bien encaminados para alcanzar nuestra meta. Gracias por tu generosidad.

CSA financia muchos programas en la Arquidiócesis de Detroit. Un programa que afecta a muchas personas es el Tribunal Matrimonial Metropolitano. Si ya recibió un divorcio, antes de que pueda casarse en la Iglesia Católica, su primer matrimonio debe ser evaluado para determinar su validez y si está libre para casarse. Esto se conoce comúnmente como una anulación. Esto puede tomar desde dos semanas hasta más de dos años, dependiendo de las circunstancias. No sé cuánto cuesta este proceso porque la AOD nunca le pide a la gente que pague por sus anulaciones.

Hace muchos años, se decidió que no queríamos que la falta de dinero fuera la razón por la que alguien no solicita la anulación. Por esta razón, la Arquidiócesis decidió que el proceso de anulación sería financiado a través de la CSA. A través de sus contribuciones a CSA, está ayudando a apoyar a nuestros hermanos y hermanas que buscan sanación a través del proceso de anulación, y está apoyando el sacramento del matrimonio.
