In Today's Gospel

Jesus said that love of God and love of neighbor are the most important commandments. They are inseparable. To love our neighbor is to share in the love of God. If we love God, then we love all that he has created. In today's gospel, Jesus tells us that if we love father or mother, or son or daughter more than him, we are not worthy of him. If we love the created more than the creator, then we deny the self-giving love that is God, and we are not worthy of him.

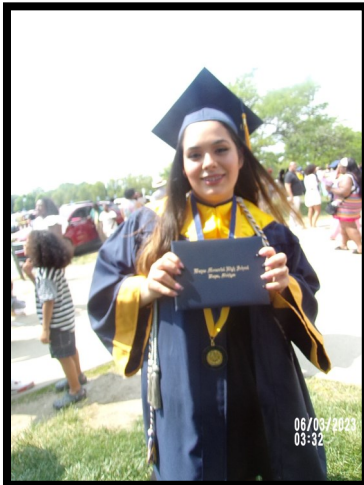

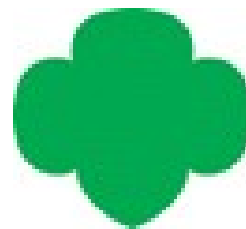
***Catholic Religious Medals Day Camp for Girl Scouts***
