Notes from Fr. Sean

In today's Gospel

"Who do you say that I am?" (Mt 16:15b) This is the question that Jesus asked his disciples in today's gospel, and it is a question that he asks us today. As Catholics, we profess that he is "God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God." Is that belief reflected in the way we live our lives?

To know Jesus, we must spend time with him. We spend time with him in prayer and when we read scripture. We spend time with him at Mass and when we receive his body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist. Let us spend time with Jesus, and when we are asked "Who do you say that I am?" we can respond: "My God and my friend."

En el Evangelio de Hoy

"¿Quién dicen que soy yo?" (Mt 16:15b) Esta es la pregunta que Jesús hizo a sus discípulos en el evangelio de hoy, y es una pregunta que nos hace a nosotros hoy. Como católicos, profesamos que él es "Dios de Dios, Luz de Luz, Dios verdadero de Dios verdadero". ¿Se refleja esa creencia en la forma en que vivimos nuestras vidas?

Para conocer a Jesús, debemos pasar tiempo con él. Pasamos tiempo con él en oración y cuando leemos las Escrituras. Pasamos tiempo con él en misa y cuando recibimos su cuerpo, sangre, alma y divinidad en la Eucaristía. Pasemos tiempo con Jesús, y cuando nos preguntan "¿Quién decís que soy yo?" podemos responder: "Dios mío y amigo mío".

Blessed Solanus Casey

On Christmas Eve, 1896, the 26-year-old son of Irish immigrants from Wisconsin arrived at the St. Bonaventure Monastery in Detroit. Three weeks later, Bernard Casey entered the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin, taking the name Solanus. After many struggles, Solanus was ordained to the priesthood on July 24, 1904. He served his first 20 years as a priest in various locations in New York. He is best known for his time at St. Bonaventure Monastery, beginning in 1924.

Although Fr. Solanus could celebrate Mass, he was not permitted to preach or to hear confessions. As a result, he served as porter for the monastery. His humble acceptance of this role brought Fr. Solanus into contact with people in need, and he became known for his wise counsel. During his life, Fr. Solanus was recognized for his saintly life. On October 12, 2015, Fr. Solanus, now Blessed Solanus Casey, was beatified. The investigation into his life and miracles continues, and we hope that one day, he will be recognized as a Saint.

This week, The Nankin Family of Parishes will be hosting a relic of Bl. Solanus, a bone from his hand. The relic will be available for veneration at each of the parishes in our Family, at various times during the week. Beato Solanus Casey

En la víspera de Navidad de 1896, el hijo de 26 años de inmigrantes irlandeses de Wisconsin llegó al Monasterio de San Buenaventura en Detroit. Tres semanas después, Bernard Casey ingresó en la Orden de los Frailes Menores Capuchinos, tomando el nombre de Solanus. Después de muchas luchas, Solanus fue ordenado sacerdote el 24 de julio de 1904. Sirvió sus primeros 20 años como sacerdote en varios lugares de Nueva York. Es mejor conocido por su estancia en el Monasterio de San Buenaventura, a partir de 1924.

Aunque el P. Solano podía celebrar misa, no se le permitía predicar ni confesar. Como resultado, sirvió como portero del monasterio. Su humilde aceptación de este papel llevó al P. Solanus entró en contacto con personas necesitadas y se hizo conocido por sus sabios consejos. Durante su vida, el P. Solanus fue reconocido por su vida santa. El 12 de octubre de 2015, el P. Solanus, ahora Beato Solanus Casey, fue beatificado. La investigación sobre su vida y sus milagros continúa y esperamos que algún día sea reconocido como Santo.

Esta semana, la Familia de Parroquias Nankin albergará una reliquia del Bl. Solanus, un hueso de su mano. La reliquia estará disponible para veneración en cada una de las parroquias de nuestra Familia, en varios momentos de la semana. 
