In Today's Gospel

We are called together as God's people, as the Church. Whether it is to settle disputes, offer prayer, or simply be in the presence of God, we are called together as the Church. The word church, as it is used in today's gospel, means far more than the building where we worship or even the organization to which we belong.

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the word church has "three inseparable meanings: the People that God gathers in the whole world; the particular or local church (diocese); and the liturgical (above all Eucharistic) assembly." (Glossary) When we gather to seek God, we are not alone. God is with us; we are the Church. Together, let us offer our prayers in the name of Jesus and know that he is in our midst.

Do you know someone seeking meaning in life and asking the "Big Questions"?

- Why is there something rather than nothing?
- Why am I Here?
- Who is God ?

Or are YOU that person asking these questions and seeking more?

- Are you considering becoming Catholic, or maybe just exploring?
- Are you interested in learning about the Catholic Faith?

Many who ponder these questions enjoy the OCIA (formerly RCIA) process.

OCIA, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, formerly called RCIA, is a journey of inquiry and discovery for people seeking more in this life... and life hereafter. It is for those seeking Beauty, Truth, and Goodness who want to know what the Catholic Church teaches. OCIA is also for discovering who Jesus Christ is and nurturing a relationship with Him. OCIA is not a class but a conversion process with no set timetable. For many, initiation into the Church via the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist is celebrated at the Great Easter Vigil Mass. If you are reading this, you are likely already a Catholic. Seekers will not see this invitation until you share it with them. So Please Do That!!! Be a witness and kindly suggest the idea of OCIA to a dear neighbor or family member who may be asking the big questions.

Who is the Candidate for the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults?

- People who have never been baptized in any Christian Faith.
- People baptized in another Christian Faith or Catholics who had not continued in the faith, have never received the Sacrament of Eucharist, and have not been Confirmed.
- People who are not part of any faith or practice another religion and would like to convert to Catholicism.
- Catholics who wish to accompany seekers through OCIA
- discernment and learn more about religion.
