# Notes from Fr. Sean

## In today's gospel

"That's not fair." If I were one of the laborers hired first thing in the morning in today's gospel, I do not doubt that you would have heard me crying out, "That's not fair when I saw those who only worked a few hours getting paid the same. To our human understanding of fairness, I would be right. But God acts with mercy, giving us every opportunity to receive that mercy, even to the last moment of our lives. Do I want one God to be fair, or do I want his mercy?

Throughout Scripture, many images of the family represent the relationship between God and his people. God is our father. Through baptism, we become the adopted sons and daughters of God. We are called into one family by Jesus Christ.

Last week, St. Mary, I spoke of the importance of our commitment to our family, the Church. Both St. Mary and St. Richard exist because of you. It is your commitment that enables us to serve our community. I asked you to reflect on your commitment to the Church and how you can continue in that commitment.
