Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

In our readings today, we saw the aftermath of the great flood. During the flood, it rained for 40 days. Following that, God entered into a covenant with Noah. The 40 days of rain purified the earth in preparation for the covenant God would enter into with Noah. Although Jesus did not need to be purified, in today's gospel, he spent 40 days in the desert preparing for his public ministry. In the Gospel of Luke, we are told that during that time, Jesus ate nothing and that when they were over, "he was hungry." (Lk 1:2) This may seem to be a strange way to prepare for something. By exposing himself to weakness, Jesus exposed himself to temptation by the devil. Our flesh is weak. If we rely on the flesh, we will fall to temptation. Jesus did not put his faith in his human flesh but in his divinity. Let us put our faith in God. With him, we can do great things.

En el Evangelio de Hoy

En nuestras lecturas de hoy, vimos las consecuencias del gran diluvio. Durante la inundación llovió durante 40 días. Después de eso, Dios hizo un pacto con Noé. Los 40 días de lluvia purificaron la tierra en preparación para el pacto que Dios haría con Noé. Aunque Jesús no necesitaba ser purificado, en el evangelio de hoy pasó 40 días en el desierto preparándose para su ministerio público. En el Evangelio de Lucas se nos dice que durante ese tiempo Jesús no comió nada y que cuando terminaron "tenía hambre". (Lucas 1:2) Esta puede parecer una forma extraña de prepararse para algo. Al exponerse a la debilidad, Jesús se expuso a la tentación del diablo. Nuestra carne es débil. Si confiamos en la carne, caeremos en la tentación. Jesús no puso su fe en su carne humana sino en su divinidad. Pongamos nuestra fe en Dios. Con él podemos hacer grandes cosas.

40 Days

Throughout Scripture, 40 is a powerful number. We see the 40 days that it rained on Noah. The children of Israel spent 40 years in the desert. Jesus spent 40 days in the desert at the beginning of his ministry, and after his resurrection, he spent 40 days on earth before he ascended into heaven.

40 is a symbol of preparation or cleansing. As we prepare to celebrate the sacrifice that Christ offered for us on Good Friday and his resurrection on Easter Sunday, we spend Lent preparing ourselves. Through the spiritual practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we seek to overcome temptation in our lives. We strengthen ourselves against the temptations of the flesh, the world, and the devil. Take advantage of this time to prepare for Easter.

40 Días

A lo largo de la Escritura, 40 es un número poderoso. Vemos los 40 días que llovió sobre Noé. Los hijos de Israel pasaron 40 años en el desierto. Jesús pasó 40 días en el desierto al comienzo de su ministerio, y después de su resurrección, pasó 40 días en la tierra antes de ascender al cielo.

El 40 es un símbolo de preparación o limpieza. Mientras nos preparamos para celebrar el sacrificio que Cristo ofreció por nosotros el Viernes Santo y su resurrección el Domingo de Pascua, pasamos la Cuaresma preparándonos. A través de las prácticas espirituales de la oración, el ayuno y la limosna, buscamos superar la tentación en nuestras vidas. Nos fortalecemos contra las tentaciones de la carne, el mundo y el diablo. Aprovecha este tiempo para prepararte para la Semana Santa.

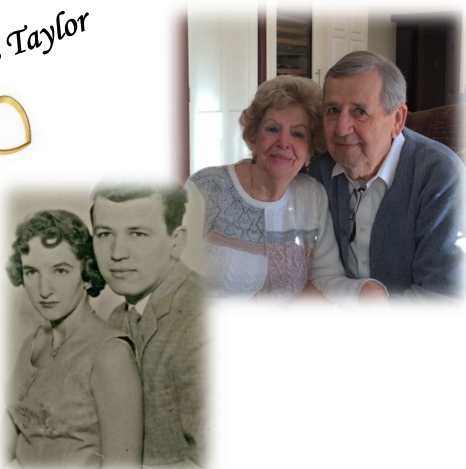
