### Notes from Fr. Sean

#### In Today's Gospel

We are halfway through Lent. During this season of penance, we are called to be converted to the Gospel. In today's Gospel, we are told that God does not condemn us for our sins; rather, we condemn ourselves. Jesus came into the world to bring salvation. Let us reject the darkness of sin and embrace the light of Christ.

#### En el Evangelio de hoy

Estamos a mitad de la Cuaresma. Durante este tiempo de penitencia, estamos llamados a convertirnos al Evangelio. En el Evangelio de hoy se nos dice que Dios no nos condena por nuestros pecados, sino que somos nosotros quienes nos condenamos. Jesús vino al mundo para traer la salvación. Rechacemos las tinieblas del pecado y abracemos la luz de Cristo.

#### Confession and Contrition

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) refers to three things necessary for good confession: confession, contrition, and satisfaction. (1450) Confession means telling the priest your sins, especially all serious sins. Satisfaction seeks to "repair the harm" caused by sin. (CCC 1459) It may be something as simple as a few prayers, or it may mean returning something that was stolen. Satisfaction seeks to restore our relationship with God and our neighbors.

Perhaps the most difficult part of confession is contrition. Contrition is far more than the prayer said at the end of confession. The CCC defines it as "Sorrow of the soul and hatred for the sin committed, together with a resolution not to sin again. Contrition is the most important act of the penitent and is necessary for the reception of the Sacrament of Penance." (Glossary) The Act of Contrition that we recite should reflect the sorrow we have in our hearts for our sins and a commitment to overcome sin in our lives. There are many versions of the Act of Contrition that you can recite when making your confession, or you can make up your own.

I like to recite the Act of Contrition I learned as a child. I reflect on its words, which reflect my sorrow, not only out of fear of punishment but because I have offended the loving God I should love with all my heart. The prayer then goes on to express my commitment to avoid sin in the future. While I know I will sin again, I am expressing my desire to overcome sin. This desire is the contrition necessary for a good confession. As you prepare for confession during this season of penance, reflect on your sins, bring them to God, and seek his grace to sin no more.

#### Confesión y contrición

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (CIC) se refiere a tres cosas necesarias para una buena confesión: confesión, contrición y satisfacción. (1450) Confesión significa decir al sacerdote tus pecados, especialmente todos los pecados graves. La satisfacción busca reparar el daño causado por el pecado (CIC 1459) Puede ser algo tan sencillo como unas oraciones, o puede significar devolver algo que nos han robado. La satisfacción busca restaurar nuestra relación con Dios y con el prójimo.

Quizás la parte más difícil de la confesión es la contrición. La contrición es mucho más que la oración que se dice al final de la confesión. El CIC la define como "Dolor del alma y odio por el pecado cometido, junto con el propósito de no volver a pecar". La contrición es el acto más importante del penitente y es necesaria para la recepción del Sacramento de la Penitencia." (Glosario) El Acto de Contrición que recitamos debe reflejar el dolor que tenemos en el corazón por nuestros pecados y el compromiso de superar el pecado en nuestras vidas. Hay muchas versiones del Acto de Contrición que puedes recitar cuando te confiesas, o puedes inventar la tuya propia.

A mí me gusta recitar el Acto de Contrición que aprendí de niño. Reflexiono sobre sus palabras, que reflejan mi dolor, no sólo por miedo al castigo, sino porque he ofendido al Dios amoroso que debería amar con todo mi corazón. A continuación, la oración expresa mi compromiso de evitar el pecado en el futuro. Aunque sé que volveré a pecar, expreso mi deseo de superar el pecado. Este deseo es la contrición necesaria para una buena confesión. Mientras te preparas para la confesión durante este tiempo de penitencia, reflexiona sobre tus pecados, llévaselos a Dios y busca su gracia para no pecar más.
