In Today's Gospel

Mary 7 St. Richard

At the time of Jesus, the people were looking for the Messiah. John the Baptist came, preaching a baptism of repentance of sins. His message was so powerful that the people thought he might be the Messiah. In today's Gospel, John tells the people that his baptism is only a symbol, but that one mightier than he was coming would baptize the "Holy Spirit and fire." We have been baptized by Christ. The Holy Spirit has descended upon us, as he did on Christ in the Jordan. Let us proclaim this good news. We have become sons and daughters of God.

En el Evangelio de hoy

En tiempos de Jesús, el pueblo buscaba al Mesías. Llegó Juan el Bautista, predicando un bautismo de arrepentimiento de los pecados. Su mensaje fue tan poderoso que la gente pensó que podría ser el Mesías. En el Evangelio de hoy, Juan dice a la gente que su bautismo es sólo un símbolo, pero que venía uno más poderoso que él que bautizaría con «Espíritu Santo y fuego». Nosotros hemos sido bautizados por Cristo. El Espíritu Santo ha descendido sobre nosotros, como lo hizo sobre Cristo en el Jordán. Proclamemos esta buena noticia. Nos hemos convertido en hijos e hijas de Dios.

Three Epiphanies

In the West, we focus on the visit of the Magi when we think of the Epiphany, but there are three events in the life of Christ that we use the word Epiphany to describe: the Visit of the Magi, the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River (which we celebrate today), and the Wedding Feast at Cana. In the Eastern Church, the Epiphany focuses on the Baptism of Jesus. In each of these events, the divinity of Christ is revealed, first by the star guiding the Magi, then by the Holy Spirit descending upon Jesus like a dove, and finally through his first public miracle.

Tres Epifanías

En Occidente, nos centramos en la visita de los Reyes Magos cuando pensamos en la Epifanía, pero hay tres acontecimientos en la vida de Cristo que describimos con la palabra Epifanía: la visita de los Reyes Magos, el Bautismo de Jesús en el Jordán (que celebramos hoy) y las Bodas de Caná. En la Iglesia de Oriente, la Epifanía se centra en el Bautismo de Jesús. En cada uno de estos acontecimientos, la divinidad de Cristo se revela, primero por la estrella que guía a los Magos, luego por el Espíritu Santo que desciende sobre Jesús como una paloma y, por último, a través de su primer milagro público.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

The Creed

A smart, serious explanation of Christianity for skeptics, seekers, and nonbelievers!

Recent decades have witnessed a surge of the religiously unaffiliated, especially among young people. Many former believers have turned their backs on Christianity and no longer accept its teachings. But what are those teachings? And are they the same as what so many people reject?

In **The Creed**, a new film series blending documentary footage and dynamic talks, <u>Bishop Robert Barron guides viewers into</u> the depths of the <u>Nicene Creed</u>, a fourth-century statement of faith that has profoundly influenced Eastern and Western spirituality, theology, and liturgy.

This program is free. We will study the CREED explained by Bp Barron for six weeks, and the workbook (no charge) is available online.


