In Today's Gospel

In today's gospel, Jesus says, "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." Let us embrace this command of Jesus. Let us not only love our enemies but also love and pray for those who disagree with us. They are not our enemies.

Preparing for Lent

Lent begins in 10 days. During Lent, we are called to the spiritual exercises of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. We often focus on fasting during Lent; however, true spiritual growth comes through all these spiritual exercises. As we prepare for Lent, it is good to think about how we will live out these practices.

Prayer is something we should be doing every day. During Lent, extra focus prayer. Prayer is conversation with God. There are many ways that we can do this. We can read the Bible 15 minutes a day, pray the Rosary, or attend the Stations of the Cross. In doing this, we are spending time with God.

Fasting means giving something up. Traditionally, this meant giving up food. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, we are called to fast from food. Today, fasting can mean giving up anything I find pleasurable. It could mean giving up chocolate or pop. It could also mean giving up TikTok or YouTube videos. The point behind fasting is that by giving up something we desire, we control our desires instead of letting them control us.

Almsgiving means giving money to charity. There are many worthy charities you can support. By giving money to charity, we not only help those in need, but we also demonstrate that what we have is for the good of all, not just for ourselves. By practicing these spiritual exercises, we can make Lent a spiritually fulfilling time as we prepare for the Resurrection of Christ.

Preparación de la Cuaresma

La Cuaresma comienza dentro de 10 días. Durante este tiempo, estamos llamados a realizar ejercicios espirituales como la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. A menudo nos centramos en el ayuno, pero el verdadero crecimiento espiritual se produce a través de todos ellos. Mientras nos preparamos para ella, es bueno pensar en cómo viviremos estas prácticas.

La oración es algo que deberíamos hacer todos los días. Durante la Cuaresma, centrémonos más en ella. La oración es una conversación con Dios. Hay muchas maneras de hacerlo. Podemos leer la Biblia durante 15 minutos al día, rezar el Rosario o asistir al Vía Crucis. De este modo, pasaremos tiempo con Dios.

Ayunar significa renunciar a algo. Tradicionalmente, esto significaba no comer. El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo estamos llamados a hacerlo. Hoy en día, ayunar puede significar renunciar a cualquier cosa que resulte placentera. Puede significar no comer chocolate ni gaseosas. También puede significar dejar de usar TikTok o de ver vídeos de YouTube. Lo importante del ayuno es que, al renunciar a algo que deseamos, controlamos nuestros deseos en lugar de dejar que ellos nos controlen.

Dar limosna significa donar dinero a una organización benéfica. Hay muchas organizaciones benéficas a las que se puede donar. Al donar dinero a la caridad, no solo ayudamos a los necesitados, sino que también demostramos que nuestra riqueza está al servicio de todos, no solo de nosotros mismos. Si practicamos estos ejercicios espirituales, podemos hacer de la Cuaresma un tiempo espiritualmente satisfactorio mientras nos preparamos para la Resurrección de Cristo.


