Our new tuition rates are posted **here**. Please, if you haven't, take advantage of applying for Financial Aid if you should need it. We want every one of our students to re-enroll and not have tuition be a gating factor.

What is the Excellence in Education Annual Fund?

The Excellence in Education
Annual Fund is designed to
bridge the gap between tuition
and what it actually costs to
educate a child at St. Charles
Borromeo Catholic School. Every



gift greatly contributes to the high quality education St. Charles is able to provide for its students.

Where does the money go?

60% of gifts received are invested in the Excellence in Education Annual Fund, which provides income for scholarships and keeps tuition increases to a minimum. The remaining 40% percent goes directly to the school's operating budget to support faculty and staff, program, and facilities investments.

Did you know for the 2021-2022 it costs \$10,600 to educate a child at St. Charles? However, our in parish tuition rate is \$5,900. The *Excellence in Education Annual Fund* helps us cover that \$4,700 gap per child.

It is our goal for us to come together as a community to see 100% participation amongst our families. Every donation matters! We ask that you prayerfully consider what your family is able to contribute. As of today 52% of families have donated. Let's rise together to get to 100%!


