



There are bags of toiletries on sale at school as well for \$10 for a bag.

• It is optional to add hairbrushes, hair accessories, a toy, or any other extra goodies you may find.

• Please make sure that it is a size and weight that your child can carry. Each student will be asked to process up to the altar with their shoe donation.

• Please have your child bring in their shoe donation when coming to school the morning of Friday, December 9th and not earlier. We don't have enough room to store the shoes for the week. Thank you in advance!




