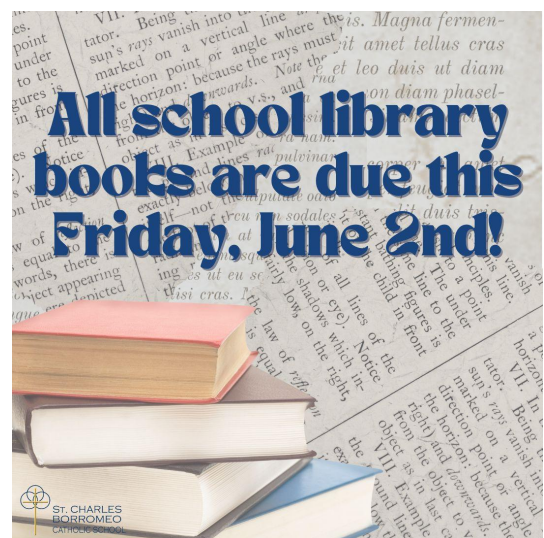
As I was reminded many times today, we are only 2 weeks out and it is summer. As we get ready, let us know here in the office if you need a thing - we're here!

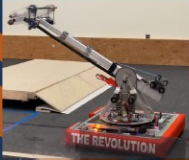
