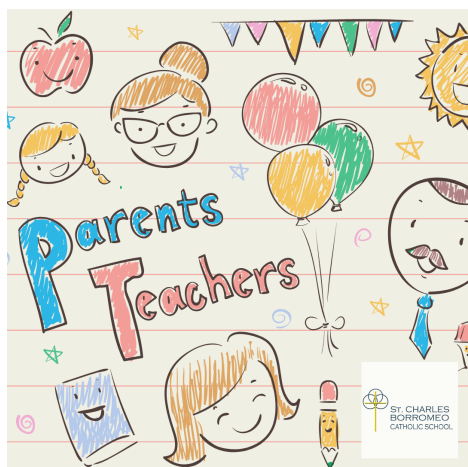

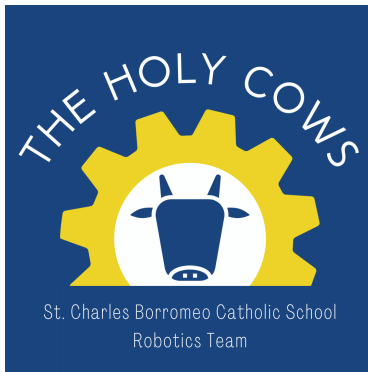
Any medications left in the Health Office AFTER June 14th will be discarded.
