SCB Families:

Well it is official - the teachers are in the building! We spent all day planning and learning and getting ready to welcome our kids back tomorrow. It was a great day of togetherness and discussion about our plans for the year.

We look forward to seeing you tomorrow for supply drop off and then again for our first day on Wednesday. Please note that



for our students in Preschool through 3rd grades, on our first official day of school on Wednesday, you can park and walk your child into the classroom for a quick hug and a photo in their classroom.

Here are the special locations for drop off on the first day of school, **Wednesday** 8/30. Staff will be monitoring every door to help with questions and ensure student safety.

- Preschool and PreK students can line up to enter near the West Parking lot/Advancement office door.
- Kindergarten and 1st graders can enter through our main school door.
- 2nd and 3rd graders will walk through the West Parking lot and enter the building through the farthest southern door (the outside door by Mrs. George's and Mrs. Mercer's classrooms).
- 4th through 8th graders enter through their normal drop off zones.

On Thursday, 8/31, all classes will queue up as per normal practice (that practice is detailed below). On Thursday, morning care and afterschool care will also begin.

We will have entrances marked to make it clear especially for those families who are new to our campus.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

Morning Drop Off

Morning Drop Off (Begins at 8:20 AM):

You are welcome to park and walk your student(s) to any of these drop off points

Preschool and PreK: Side door on the west side of the building (near the Advancement Office) *Preschool and PreK students should be escorted by an adult*

<u>Kindergarten - Third Grade:</u> Main Entrance of the school (K-2 students stay in Feist Hall and 3rd Grade students walk to their classroom)

You can enter on the West Side of 12th St and drive slowly through Farrens Freeway and do a quick stop to drop off your students.

Fourth & Fifth Grade: East Parking Lot (Behind church) students will enter the door closest to 4th Grade classrooms

Middle School (6th, 7th & 8th): Parish Center (between Feist Hall and the Church), please drive through Farrens Freeway (the drop off lane) to drop off your student.

Afternoon Pick Up

<u>Preschool - 3rd Grade:</u> West Parking Lot (older siblings can join younger siblings). Drivers, please pull through and face Meyer St. when you park. We ask that everyone who parks in our West lot park so they can pull forward versus backup as you leave.

Fourth Grade - Fifth Grade: East Parking Lot (behind church)

<u>Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Grade:</u> In front of the Parish Center, please use Farrens Freeway.

Please keep your speed to 5 miles an hour, follow the painted arrows, drive Eastbound through Farrens Freeway.



If your child has medication for daily or emergency use, please make sure the **Medication Authorization form** is filled out and on file with the office along with the medication in the original packaging.






