

This is one of the best summaries about the disciple, Simon Peter. Peter is the disciple who inspires us to keep on going in spite of our flaws and our mistakes. To begin again with a repentant heart – 20 times a day, 30 times a day – 100 times a day! "But what was most fascinating to me as I took a closer look at the Peter stories in the Gospels is that, regardless of the Gospel writer, Peter is nearly always portrayed as a flawed disciple—one who seeks to follow Jesus, yet one who is also confused, afraid, and faltering. So much so that, when his faithfulness mattered most, he denied knowing Jesus."
