#### **Happy Pentecost Sunday**

The Celts had a name for the Holy Spirit, An Geadh-Glas, translated as "the Wild Goose". Not a fragile, domesticated dove but a wild, untamed goose. We find that the Holy Spirit often makes people nervous, just like walking by geese sometimes makes us nervous. You can't know what the Spirit is going to do and this uncertainty can cause anxiety – an anxiety similarly felt when walking by live geese. This nervousness has caused us to attempt taming the Holy Spirit. But the Spirit of God cannot be tamed. We try to control the Holy Spirit (by trying to live according to our plans, not God's) and forget that the Spirit will blow where the Spirit wills (Jn3:8)
