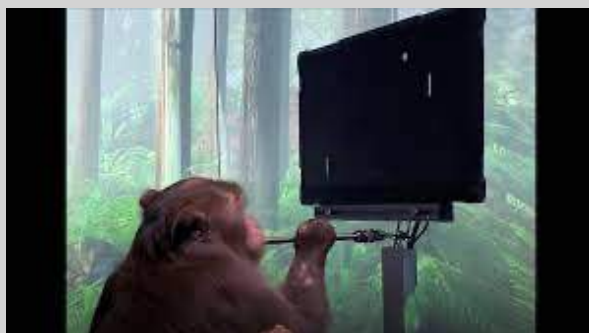

New Neuralink Release

This month, Elon Musk's company Neuralink, released footage of a macaque monkey playing mind pong. This footage was an example of the potential capabilities of the new mind chips. Neuralink planted two high tech brain chips into the monkey's head and taught him how to interact with a computer. He was taught to use a joystick to move a cursor to a target on a screen. As a reward, he would suck a banana smoothie through a straw. The brain chips monitored the monkey's neurons responsible for its hand movements. That information was then streamed to a computer algorithm that decoded the data. Neuralink was able to train the algorithm, and the monkey was able to ditch the joystick and play pong just with its mind. The monkey was able to move the cursor by just thinking about moving his hand up and down. Neuralink has also installed a prototype in a pig to demonstrate its ability to transmit neural signals.

Neuralink hopes to eventually use brain chips so that paralyzed people can interact with computers and smartphones by just thinking about it. In the future, Neuralink hopes to create new chips that could be planted in other parts of the body, so that paraplegics can move and walk again.

Minecraft is a video game full of fun and adventure. Based on the name of the game, you can tell that Minecraft is a game where you mine blocks and craft materials to beat the game. But in the game, there are animals and monsters you need to defeat to win. These are called mobs, and because there are so many of them, this will be a tier list of the top 3 best mobs.

Number 3: Creeper

Creepers are hostile mobs, or mobs that will attack you. They are mostly different shades of green with a black face. It is about two blocks tall and has four little stubby legs. Creepers have the ability to blow up whenever they are within 3 blocks of you. When they are slain manually and don't blow up itself, they drop gunpowder. I like these mobs because they are a classic in the Minecraft community and are one of the original mobs. In general, creepers are classic mobs that have an explosive power and that's why they are in the number 3 slot.

Number 2: Pig

Pigs are non hostile mobs, or mobs that won't attack you. They look like a blocky cartoon pig, all pink and adorable. When you kill them, they drop pork chops that you can cook and eat. There are also baby pigs that are smaller and more adorable versions of pigs. Pigs have no special abilities, but you can ride them if you put a saddle on them. I like pigs mostly because baby pigs are the most adorable mob in Minecraft. Even though baby pigs do not drop materials when slain, they are still amazing. In general, pigs are an adorable mob that doesn't do harm and I like them a lot.

Number 1: Enderman

Endermen are the best mob in Minecraft by far. They are neutral mobs, but they get violent when you make eye contact with them. They are 3 blocks tall and are all black with purple eyes. They have very long legs and arms. They are also the only mob to spawn in all 3 dimensions, the Overworld, the Nether, and the End. Endermen can teleport anywhere up to 32 blocks away, which I think is awesome. They can also pick up almost any block, which no other mob can. Another reason why I love Endermen is because my favorite streamer on Twitch, Ranboo, is half Enderman and half an unknown mob. He has some abilities like an Enderman and participates in a role play server where he plays a very interesting character. Additionally, in Super Smash Bros. Ultimate, you can use a shorter Enderman as a playable character. In general, Enderman are super cool because of their abilities, who they associate with, and how they can be played in other games.
