A Message from Archabbot Douglas Nowicki

Solemnity of Christ , King of the Universe

November 20, 2022

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ, the King of the Universe. This feast day was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 in the context of the hopelessness and despair that characterized the world in the aftermath of World War I. With poverty and economic failure on the horizon, panic and desperation had a firm grasp on the future,. Prospects for a brighter future seemed to be an illusion. Secularism and Communism—a world without God—were on the rise in the 1920's and 1930's.

With the rapid expansion of atheistic Communism and the rise of nationalist dictatorships in many countries (France, Spain), Hitler, Nazi Germany), Franco (Fascist Italy), Stalin (Communist Russia), Mao (Marxist Communism in China), socio-political dictators in Hungary and throughout Eastern Europe, Military dictators in South America and Apartheid in South Africa, the world was adrift. The Spirit of atheism and anti—Catholic/anti -Christian sentiment dominated the geopolitical landscape everywhere. “There is no God” became the rallying point of dictators seeking world domination. The dictators, themselves became “the gods.”

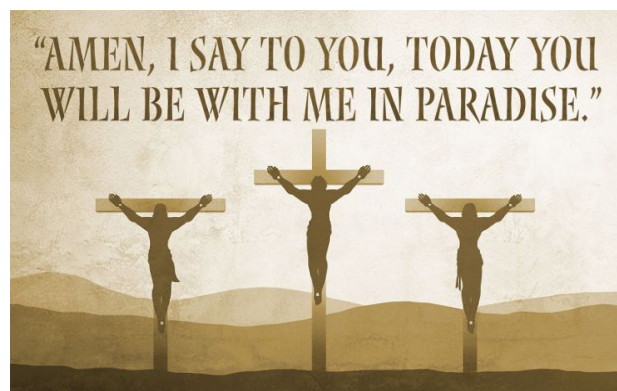
In an effort to counteract the rapid expansion of secularism and atheism in the world, Pope Pius XI in his encyclical Quas Primas (“In the First”) established the Feast of Christ the King. For all of humankind, there was only one supreme and powerful King of the Universe— Jesus Christ. The only antidote to the poisonous spirits of secularism and atheism afflicting all of the world was faith in Jesus Christ—the Redeemer and salvation of all humankind.

In his encyclical, Pope Pius, XI noted that there is only one Kingdom—the Kingdom of Jesus Christ “whose kingdom shall never end.” The Holy Father noted that the Kingship of Christ embraces all of humanity. As our creator and redeemer, the Kingship of Jesus Christ is the gift we all embrace.

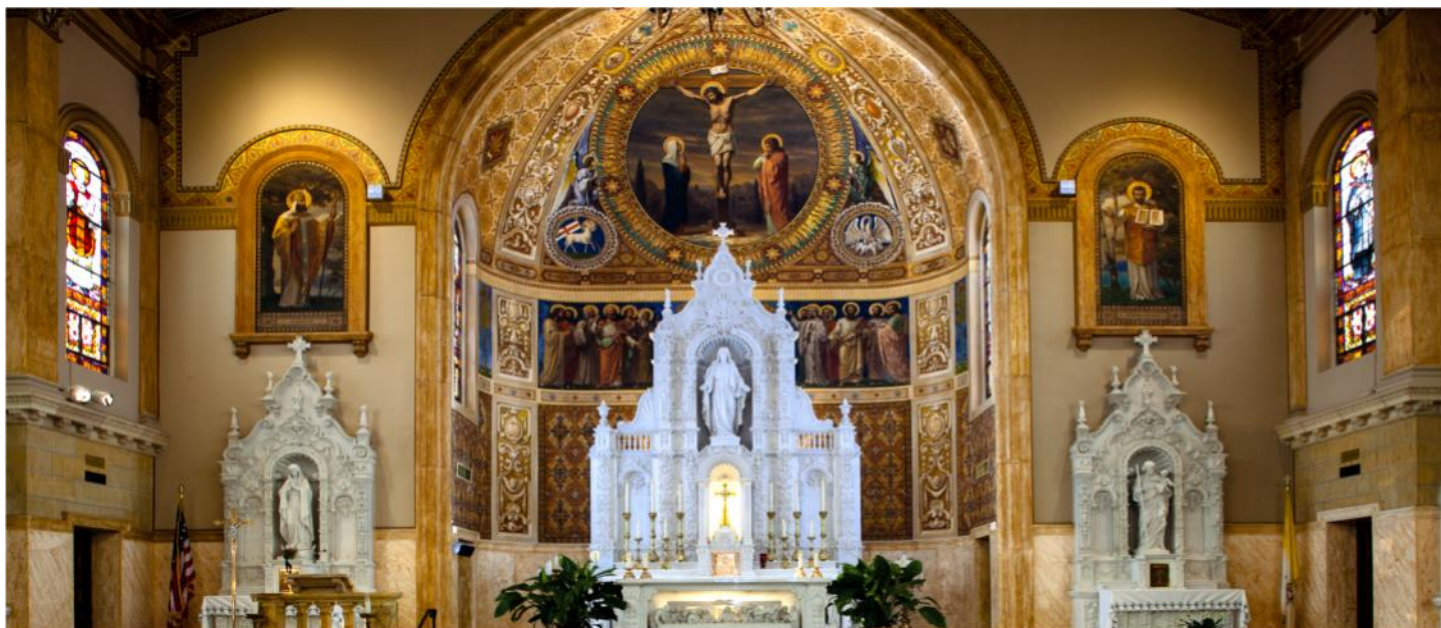

Registering in the Parish of Saint Edward

The law of the Church defines a parish as a definite community of the Christian faithful established on a stable basis within a [Diocese]. The pastoral care of the parish is entrusted to a pastor as its own shepherd under the authority of the diocesan bishop. The law of the Church also states that a parish is to be territorial and embraces all the Christian faithful within a certain territory [cc 515, 518]

The certain territory for Saint Edward Parish established at its founding is the area of Palm Beach Island from the north end of the Island south to Sloan's Curve.

To register as a parishioner of Saint Edward requires residence within its territory.

First Penance and First Eucharist Programs

Beginning in the First Grade, children of registered parishioners are to be enrolled in a two- year Parish Religious Education sacramental program. Registered parishioners whose children attend Catholic Grade Schools are to participate in the immediate sacramental preparation programs of the Parish. Please contact the parish office for more information.

Confirmation Program

Children of registered parishioners who are to be enrolled as candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation must have been baptized, capable of renewing their Baptismal promises, and properly instructed by participation in the two-year parish program beginning in the seventh grade. The Sacrament of Confirmation is usually scheduled for September, when the candidate is a ninth grader.

Marriages at Saint Edward Parish

Saint Edward Parish reserves the celebration of the sacrament of marriage to registered parishioners who are practicing Catholics and their immediate family members. Registration requires residence within the territory of the parish [the North End of the Island south to Sloan's Curve.] New parishioners must be registered for one year before being considered for the scheduling of a marriage.

Saint Edward Marriage Regulations

All couples intending to marry at Saint Edward must meet with the pastor. No date is promised or scheduled before this initial meeting with the pastor, who is to assess the freedom to marry of the couple and explain other marriage regulations. Saint Edward Parish is not a destination site for marriage and Saint Edward does not rent the Church to non-parishioners for marriage ceremonies.

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick can be administered to the sick after the age of reason when the person begins to be in danger due to sickness or age. It is preferred that the sacrament be administered when the person is in control of their faculties. Please contact the parish in emergencies. After hours leave a message as directed by the parish voicemail.
