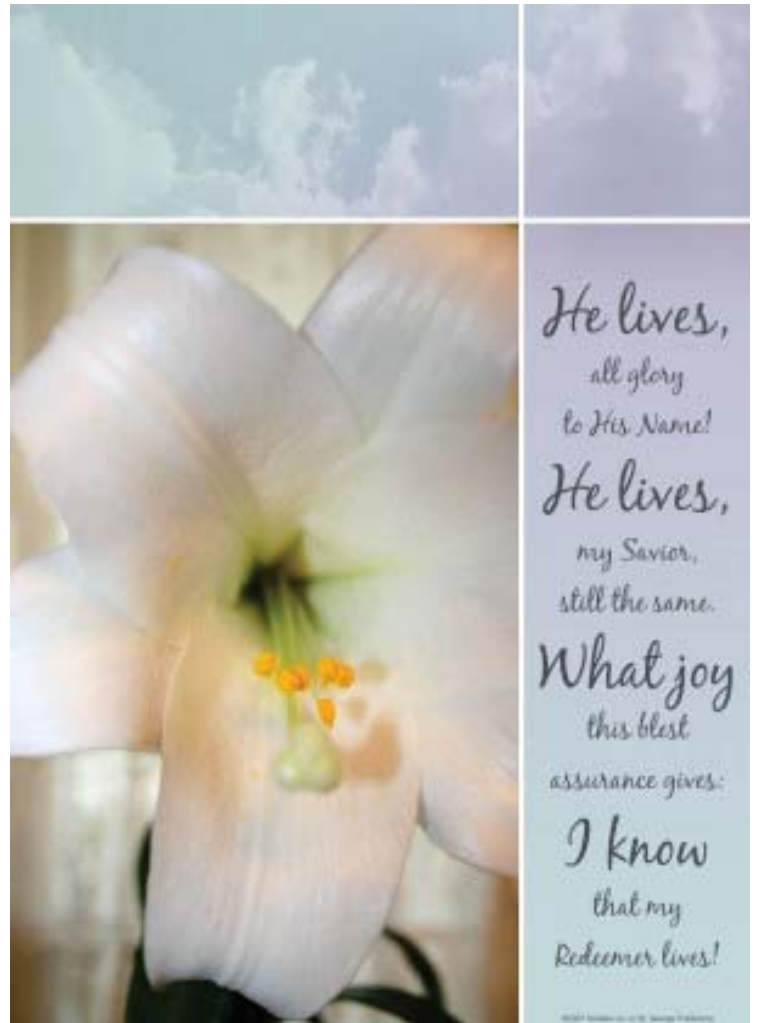

Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed!

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

With this most ancient Easter greeting, I warmly welcome you to the Concord–Carlisle Collaborative this Easter Sunday. At the heart of our Catholic faith stands the mystery we celebrate today: Jesus Christ, born, crucified, died, and risen. His Resurrection is the source of our hope and the center of our identity as a community of faith.


Easter is also a time of invitation. If you are seeking to grow in faith or to serve the community, I warmly encourage you to become involved in parish life.

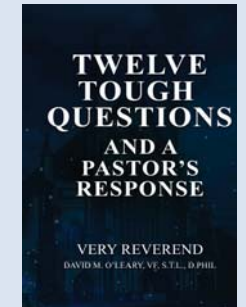

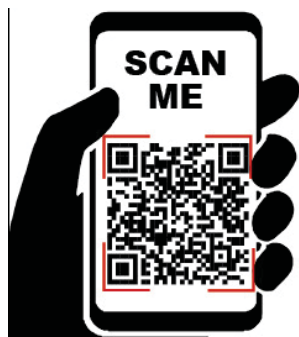

Eric Lipseir



Eric was born and raised in a Jewish home. After carefully discerning the voice of the Lord and seeking the truth with an open heart, he decided to answer the call to become a Catholic Christian. Eric was baptized, confirmed, and received his First Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. For his confirmation name, he chose Saint Cyprian of Carthage, a third-century bishop

and martyr who himself was a convert to Christianity and became a courageous witness to the faith. Through the inter-

cession of St. Cyprian, may Eric continue to grow in wisdom, courage, and love for Christ and His Church.

Charles “Charlie” Eck



Charlie was born and raised in a mixed-faith family and consequently was never baptized as a child. As a student at Concord-Carlisle High School, he began reading the Bible with friends. In doing so, he discovered a desire to know Christ more personally. This led him on a thoughtful journey of discernment about where God

was calling him to worship. That journey ultimately led him to the Catholic Church. Like Eric, Charlie was baptized, confirmed, and received his First Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Seamus Hayes



Seamus was baptized Catholic as a young child, but later his family joined the Episcopal Church, where he was confirmed and received Holy Communion. As he grew older, however, he felt a deeper longing for God that he struggled to satisfy. One day, while driving past Holy Family–St. Bernard Parish, he felt a profound sense of peace and

began discerning a return to the Catholic Church. Because he had already been confirmed in the Episcopal Church, he had to be received back into full communion with the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil through a profession of faith and the reception of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. Seamus chose Saint Michael the Archangel as his confirmation patron. Through the intercession of St. Michael, may he be defended in every spiritual battle and strengthened in faith.

Austin Calabro



Austin was baptized in the Church, but the faith was not practiced at home during his early years. As he grew older, however, he began to feel a desire for a deeper relationship with the Lord. Responding to that call, he came forward seeking formation for the sacraments. Accompanied by our Youth Minister, Tony Carbrelo, Austin spent the

past two years learning, growing, and deepening his faith. At the Easter Vigil he received Confirmation and his First Eucharist. Austin chose **Saint David of Wales** as his confirmation name. Through the intercession of St. David, may he continue to be joyful in faith, hold fast to the Creed he professed, and remember the saint's simple wisdom to "do the little things" that make God's presence visible in our world.

Clare Hwang



Clare was born and raised in the Catholic faith and has always had a deep love for the Lord and His Church. Already active in our parish, Clare is a member of our Bell Choir and can often be found in the front row at the 9:00 AM Mass at Holy Family. Even so, Clare chose to wait before receiving

Confirmation so that she could better understand and embrace the faith for herself. This past year she felt the

call to receive the sacraments and came forward in faith. At the Easter Vigil she received Confirmation and her First Eucharist. Clare kept her baptismal name, given in honor of **Saint Clare of Assisi**, whose name means "light." Through the intercession of St. Clare, may Christ continue to brighten Clare's path so that her life may shine as a light leading others to Him.

Justin Beck



Justin grew up in a non-practicing Catholic family. Although his parents ensured he received Baptism and First Eucharist, his formal faith formation ended there. As he grew older, Justin was deeply inspired by the faith of a friend's family, the friend who would later become his fiancée. He was especially moved by the witness of her father, whose reverence for the liturgy

and commitment to prayer left a lasting impression. Through their example, Justin rediscovered the beauty of the Catholic faith and chose to continue his journey toward Confirmation. At the Easter Vigil he was confirmed, with his future father-in-law serving as his sponsor. Justin chose **Saint Joseph** as his confirmation patron. Our Christian life requires that we don't journey alone. We need the people of God to accompany us on our journey of faith. That's where sponsors become invaluable. 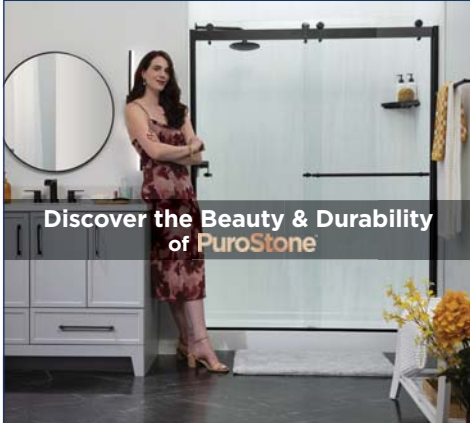

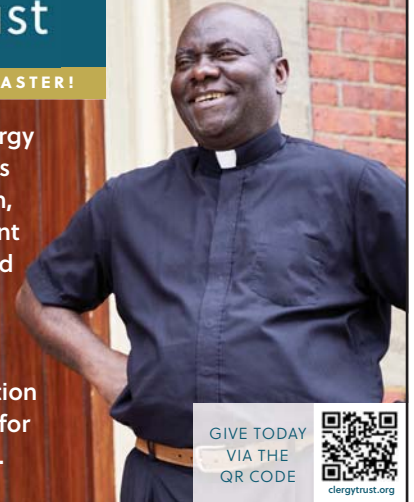
