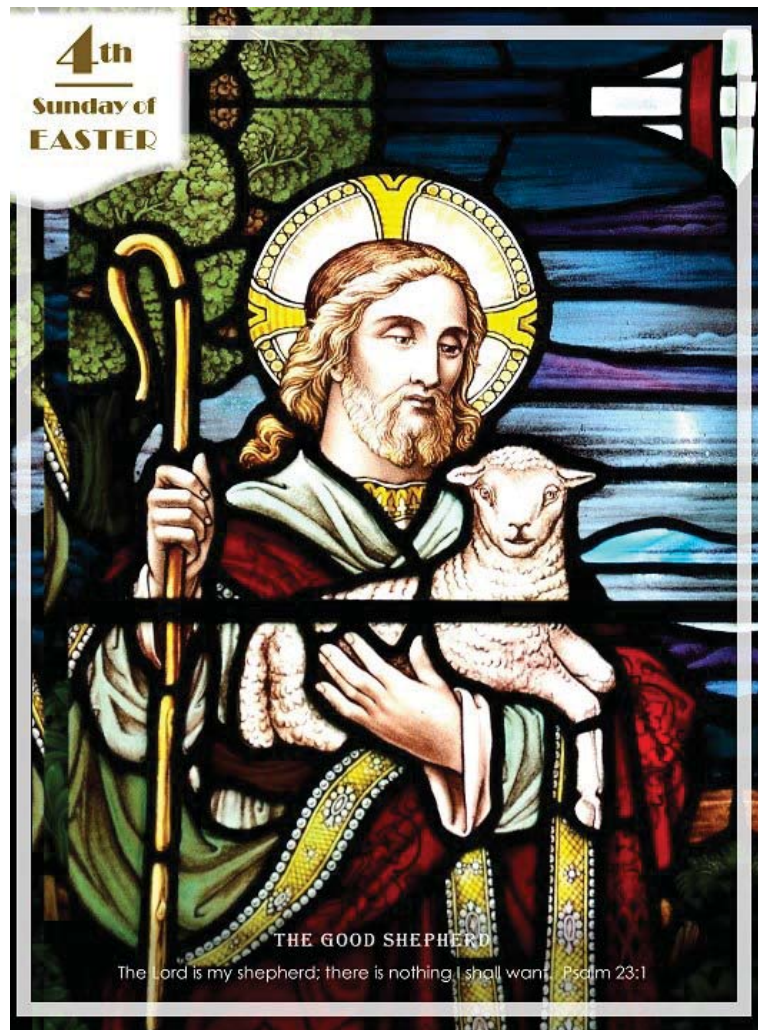

Message from Prison

Once a month I celebrate two Sunday Masses at the Women’s Prison in Framingham, Deacon Colm McGarry is the Chaplain. The women are separated between short term and long-term stays. Short term means a lesser crime; long term means a more serious crime. But the women come to Mass with their prayer intentions for their families, for their fellow inmates and even for their victims.


Last Sunday, I preached on Jesus’ words “What are you discussing as you go on your way?” The Gospel story was the Emmaus story. I shared that Jesus wants to listen and hear from us, what are we carrying in our hearts? I shared a few examples; that I did not like what the President is saying about Pope Leo. And how the Easter words of Jesus come to me; “Do not let your heart be troubled.” I shared that I worry about the bills in the parish, new roof, new heating system. And how I get the response; “Fear is useless, what is needed is trust.” I shared how I worry about being a good priest, and I get the response “My Grace is enough for you, for my power reaches perfection in your weakness.”

One of the women came up to me after Mass and said she does the same thing. Tells Jesus what is in her heart. That she does not want to hurt anyone, that she misses her children, that she is very sorry for what she has done. And she then said, she gets the message/response when she comes to Mass and receives the Eucharist; “You are mine; I love you.”

Wow.

Each and every day, may we tell Jesus what we are discussing as we go on our way. But then listen for Jesus’ words back to us. “Peace be with you”, “Be not afraid”, “Do not let your heart be troubled”, “Fear is useless what is needed is trust”, “You are mine; I love you”.

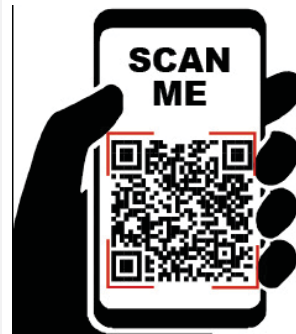

## GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's readings invite us to reflect on our willingness to hear the voice of the Lord, especially when he speaks a word that will convict our hearts. In the first reading, Peter stands up and proclaims Christ crucified and risen, and some three thousand people who heard this were "cut to the heart" and were baptized. Peter's message was not an easy one to hear; he was, in part, reminding them that they had put Jesus to death. But something about Peter's words made it clear that he was speaking the truth. And they repented. They recognized, as we hear in our second reading, that they "had gone astray like sheep" but now they "have returned to the shepherd and guardian of [their] souls." As we seek to grow in discipleship, may we learn to recognize the Lord's voice in our lives, especially when he speaks a word that convicts our hearts, because it is only through him that we find abundant life.

## REFLECT

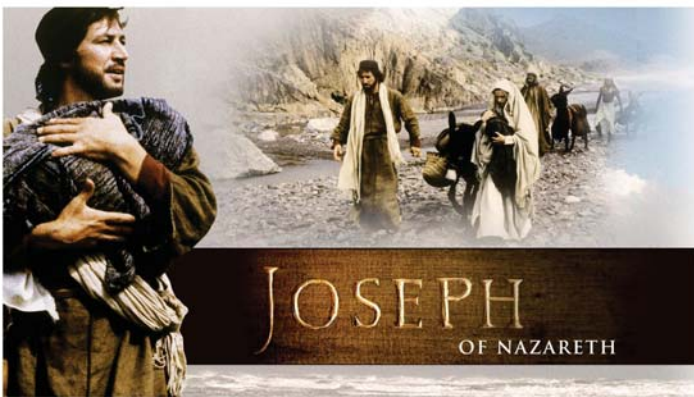
St. Ignatius of Loyola outlined several rules for the "discernment of spirits," a way of recognizing God's movement in our hearts. A simple summary of the rules says that when we stray from the Lord, the Spirit convicts our hearts, drawing us to repentance. When we are moving toward the Lord, the Spirit encourages our growth toward holiness by gifts of his peace and consolation. Spend some time reflecting on this current phase of your spiritual life. How is the voice of the Good Shepherd speaking to draw you toward his abundant life?

## GO EVANGELIZE

### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Our Gospel tells us that the sheep recognize the shepherd's voice. We "sheep" who know the Lord have the awesome task of helping others to come to know his voice. One of the most powerful tools we have at our disposal in the work of evangelizing is simply sharing about our own walk with the Lord. Take some time to talk with someone about the ways you recognize the Lord's voice in your life. Those for whom a relationship with God seems far-fetched or difficult can draw great encouragement from hearing about what that relationship looks like in your own life. Often, our own sharing can make it clear that it is possible to hear and communicate with God in a personal and life-changing way, leading them to seek that in their own life.

## April is Child Abuse Prevention Month

### “Did You Know...?”

#### Did You Know?. **Five Steps to Safer Environments**

The Archdiocese of Boston mandates that all people who work with children and youth in our parishes and schools must undergo child abuse prevention training through the VIRTUS program. Come to a Protecting God’s Children training to learn about the warning signs of an inappropriate relationship with a child, and how to help keep all kids safe. The training details five steps to prevent child sexual abuse:

- Know the warning signs!
- Control access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children and youth.
- Monitor all programs for the safety of children and youth.
- Be aware of and sensitive to what is going on in the lives of children.
- Communicate concerns to the appropriate person in authority.

*Did You Know...**Child abuse can occur in every culture and every socio-economic demographic.*** Peer reviewed research also indicates that the vast majority of child abuse occurs at the hands of someone known to the victim. You can protect children by respecting the safe environment protocols established at youth serving organizations. More importantly, you can implement many of these protocols in your home and be ever observant and vigilant in all public and private settings.

*Did you know... **Children of abuse long to hear the message of hope.*** Throughout scripture there is evidence that we are ALL called to be ambassadors of hope and healing. Victims of crime, their family and

loved ones need to know that their voices are heard. Organizations throughout the nation are striving to share the message that He has risen and there is hope. Each of us has a unique ability to support individuals who are hurting, to promote healthy relationships, and to build communities that are safe from those who may want to do harm. How has He called you to be an ambassador of hope and healing?

### Did You Know...What is happening in the Archdiocese of Boston to protect children?

Adults and youth learn how to create a safe space, identify and avoid or respond to risk, and report concerns.

All parish and school staff and volunteers must take safe environment training (PGC) to learn how to identify and prevent abuse!

Staff in the Office of Pastoral Support and Child Protection can help parishes and schools to take all necessary steps to meet the child protection requirements. Just call and talk to any of us.

The Office of Pastoral Support and Child Protection provides ongoing support for healing for those who were sexually abused in the Boston church and for their families.

A volunteer independent Review Board assists the Archbishop in reviewing new allegations of sexual abuse by priests and makes recommendations for moving forward.

An audit is conducted by an independent firm to evaluate implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. Findings are incorporated with those of other dioceses and made available in an Annual Report.

### 2026 Catholic Appeal Update (as of April 13, 2026)

We are grateful to all who have already supported this year's Catholic Appeal. Here is a simple update on our progress:

#### Holy Family (Concord)

- Goal: \$87,000
- Raised: \$37,020 (43% of goal)
- Assessment: \$53,740
- Donors: 67 households

#### St. Irene (Carlisle)

- Goal: \$48,000
- Raised: \$19,820 (41% of goal)
- Assessment: \$28,765
- Donors: 25 households

#### Where We Stand

- Both parishes are currently at about 40–43% of goal
- At this time, we are below our assessment, which means we have not yet reached the level needed to generate a parish rebate

#### Why This Matters

When we exceed our assessment, our parish receives a 40% rebate, which helps support our local ministries, programs, and parish needs.
