We return to wearing our parish color green in vestments on Sunday, June 13th (white vestments for the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is on June 6th). The Easter Candle remains placed near the baptismal font where it now remains unlit unless there is a baptism or

funeral. Ordinary Time resumes on Monday, May 24th, and continues until the First Sunday of Advent on November 28, 2021.
