OUR YEAR IN REVIEW - HIGHLIGHTS

OCTOBER 2015

- A panel of parishioners led a discussion with Bishop Remi De Roo on current issues in the Church. Over 90 people attended.
- Neighborhood gatherings were held throughout the year at six locations to discuss and reflect on Pope Francis' encyclical on the environment, *Laudato Sí*.

NOVEMBER 2015

• The annual One World Crafts Fair raised \$800; proceeds benefited various non-profit initiatives as well as people in the community.

JANUARY 2016

• Monthly Faith Alive sessions began after the masses on the topic of mercy and compassion

FEBRUARY 2016

• The Mardi Gras Talent Show and Ice Cream Social returned this year.

MARCH 2016

• Over 40 women attended a women's retreat, facilitated by Victoria

APRIL 2016

- Fr. Pat established a \$2,500 scholarship fund to support our sister parish in Nueva Trinidad with a request that parishioners match his donation. Parishioners met and exceeded that amount, donating \$3,475 by the end of the fiscal year.
- Our annual auction was a rousing success, raising more than \$21,000 for our operating expenses. An additional \$11,100 was raised in a Fund-a-Need to support several Facilities projects.

MAY 2016

• We kicked off our Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) for 2016 and exceeded our goal by more \$8,000, which will be returned to the parish to replenish our Major Reserves restricted savings account.

JUNE

• We held a celebration on June 26 to commemorate Fr. Pat's retirement as Pastor (he will continue as our Sacramental Minister), and to welcome JoAn in her new role as Pastoral Coordinator. Following a festive liturgy, which was enhanced with liturgical movement, a lunch was held featuring roast pig provided by parishioners Rosemary and Ray Rankins.

The last two years have seen us spend close to \$170,000 making improvements to the Parish Center, Roanoke House, and the Church. We have *repaired sewers, modernized heating systems, painted buildings, installed new carpet, improved the lighting and sound in the main church, updated Paddy's Place downstairs, and upgraded the women's restroom*. All of this work has been important in extending the useful life of our buildings.

At a time when many parishes are having financial difficulties, we could only accomplish these tasks because of your generous giving. I am happy to report that we have almost completed these updates and our buildings should be useful for many years to come. Next year, we are looking at starting to rebuild our reserves and we can look forward to supporting our many ministries with confidence because of your generosity in time, spirit, and financial support. Our future looks very bright.
