It is with a grateful heart that I look back on this year and see your generosity in supporting St. Patrick parish with your gifts of time, talent and treasure, as well as your overwhelming support for outreach efforts and charitable causes. ## Financial Reports

We ended the fiscal year with a positive balance. This was primarily due to a successful Friends of St. Pat's Dinner Auction, exceeding our Sunday Collections goal, a generous donation and keeping our expenses below budget.

Our Net Income increased over the previous year mainly due reduction of expenses attributable to Fr. Pat's retirement.

In addition, we had no major repair expenses, unlike the previous year when we incurred a significant expense for sewer repair work.

Finally, thanks to the Saturday morning facilities group that maintains and updates our three parish properties, our parish saves thousands of dollars every year.

# Parish Outreach

## **Custodial Collections**

Our custodial "green envelope" collections allow parishioners to make individual contributions to organizations that St. Pat's supports, namely refugees and homeless women. Currently the organizations we support include our sister parish of Nueva Trinidad and Noel House. Green envelope contributions without a designation are placed in an "as needed" account. This money is distributed according to the special needs that come to the attention of parish staff. Green envelope contributions to Noel House are not distributed directly to Noel House, but are used to support the monthly Saturday night dinners that we prepare and serve on the second Saturday of the month and for other needs as they arise.
