Note: The population within St. Patrick's boundaries has the third lowest median age of all Deanery parishes, but that low median age is not due to children or teens in the area. Rather, less than 9% of the



population is under age 19, while over half are between 20 and 29 years old. Similarly, there is a smaller percentage of the population over 70 (under 6%) than in the Deanery (8.5%). At 1.8 persons per household within the boundaries, St. Patrick's has the second lowest persons per household in the Deanery, confirming that this area is home to many single-personal, mostly young, households.
