PROCURATOR MANDATE

Having completed fourteen (14) years of age, and having an interest in this matter as a parishioner and/or donor who has supported the current patrimony of Saint Patrick Parish, Seattle, in the Archdiocese of Seattle, I oppose any intention or act by ecclesiastical authority that would result in the merger of Saint Patrick Parish with another parish; or, the neglect, *de facto* closure, relegation, demolition and/or sale of Saint Patrick Parish Church and/or its property (located on 815 E Edgar St, 98102); or the reduction in the canonical status of the Parish or Parish Church by any means which would include the removal of the Blessed Sacrament (c. 943 §1, 1°), the reduction of its use to Mass less than twice a month (c. 934 §2), and limit daily accessibility (c. 937). That my intentions and opposition to such acts will be properly communicated within the appropriate ecclesiastical appeal process, I hereby appoint **Paul Sampson, 8458 Tillicum Rd, Seattle,** Washington, 98136, as my Procurator in accord with the norms of Canon Law. By this mandate, I allow my Procurator to act in my name as the law allows, initiate petitions and appeals in accord with Canon Law to advance my interests, and to represent these interests in judicial and administrative processes of the Catholic Church related to this issue. For purposes of any proceedings, my Procurator's address as noted above is my official address for notifications and communications. In addition to the usual powers granted a Procurator in Canon Law, this mandate grants my Procurator the following powers:

- 1. The power to appoint an Advocate in Canon Law who will guard my interests in accord with the norms of law. I expect the appointment of this Advocate will grant the Advocate the power to make appeals without prior consultation of my Procurator or me, if an appeal is consistent with my intentions noted above.
- 2. The power to appoint a Procurator/Advocate in Rome if it becomes necessary to appeal this matter to any Vatican dicastery that requires representation from a Roman Advocate, including the Apostolic Signatura.
- 3. The power to appoint a Substitute Procurator, either permanent or *pro tem*, if circumstances of the case become burdensome to the Procurator or the Procurator is impeded from acting. If this occurs, my Procurator is to inform me of this action at the most reasonable opportunity. I retain the right to revoke the substitute's mandate.
- 4. The power to renounce action or strike a bargain if I have been given reasonable opportunity to be heard and take personal action.

By this mandate, I firmly establish my intention to protect my interests in this matter by pursuing appeals in accord with Canon Law, even to final appeals allowed before the Apostolic Signatura. Only an authenticated communication received by my Procurator changes my intentions expressed herein. I retain my right to receive copies of all notifications and communications sent to my Procurator on this matter, and I retain my right to reply personally.
