St Conleth's Feast Day 4th May.



Though details of his life are scarce, we are aware that St. Conleth lived in Old Connell and was a skilled metal worker. He was invited by St. Brigid to be part of her community in Kildare. This was the beginning of a double monastery, which was somewhat unique and seems to have lasted several generations. He is known as the first Bishop of Kildare. While on pilgrimage to Rome in 519 he died as a result of being attacked by wolves somewhere in Wicklow.

Over the centuries the Christian faith which Conleth lived and passed on, has accompanied our ancestors through good and difficult times. Today we live in a more secularised culture, where faith is relegated to the private sphere of life. As a result, the challenge to hand on the faith is all the more difficult. However, it would be a mistake to think that these challenges are unique to us. Conleth had to face many challenges in his mission too. In order to respond to those challenges, he had to draw on important qualities that were part of his being. These qualities include a rootedness in Christ, a deep sense of prayer, he was creative and imaginative in his approach and he was open to doing things differently. May we be inspired and encouraged by his example in our mission in Newbridge Parish today!
