

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Anointing of the Sick conveys graces and imparts gifts of strengthening in the Holy Spirit against anxiety, discouragement, and temptation, and conveys peace and fortitude (CCC 1520). These graces flow from the atoning death of Jesus Christ, for "this was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, 'He took our infirmities and bore our diseases'" (Matt 8:17).

The *Catechism* says, "The Anointing of the Sick is not a Sacrament for those ONLY at the point of death. As soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this Sacrament has certainly already arrived" (CCC 1514). All those suffering from physical, psychological or emotional illness, or those advanced in age, or awaiting surgery, may receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. As a parishioner needing an Anointing of the Sick, please call the Parish Office during normal business hours to request a Priest. After hours, please call our Sacramental Emergency Hotline at 661.586.0372.

Honoring children's boundaries teaches important lessons about consent - As we enter into the holiday season, where many of us will spend time with extended family and friends, parents should remember to pay attention to their children's comfort levels, especially when it comes to physical affection. But when children are nervous or shy, or just do not want to, it is important to honor their personal boundaries — and it teaches them a great lesson about consent over who interacts with them and their bodies. 


Christ's Kingship Extends to All of Us!

Understanding today's feast of Christ the King may be particularly challenging. To understand how Christ is our king, we extend and magnify what we know to be true of the best of human royalty. Christ's kingship extends to all places, all people, and all times. Christ manifests his Kingship through his death on the cross in which he offered salvation to everyone. 


