Dear Parish Family,

Deacon Scott Palmer is with us this weekend to share about the upcoming Together in Mission Commitment Sunday we will have in two weeks. Deacon Scott has been with us before and works with Bishop Ed Clarke, the auxiliary bishop of the Queen of Angeles Pastoral Region which comprises the City of Los Angeles. In his region there are many parishes who are beneficiaries of the Together in Mission Program, so he is a great speaker to share insights with us about the difference Together in Mission makes. Many parishes in our Archdiocese struggle to get by and provide just the minimum they can with weekly collections of often less than \$5,000.00. Together in Mission helps supplement these parishes and gives them a reliable source of support so they can continue to function in places within our Archdiocese, where the need for the Hope that Christ and the Sacraments provide is the greatest. I have personally known pastors of some of these parishes who have shared with me what a difference Together in Mission makes for them and their communities. This program is a great example of us embracing the need to take care of our own Catholic brothers and sisters, right here in our own Archdiocese. In my nineteen years as a pastor, except for the last two, I have been able to meet my parish's Together in Mission goal. This year I am grateful for the efforts many of you made as we saw more donations for Together in Mission come in the last few months. I am confident this year, as we move forward out of our current challenges related to the health crisis, that we will meet our parish goal of \$137,447.00. This is a large amount but if all our 5,000 registered families make a pledge and participate, we will easily meet our goal; I have also made a pledge that will go toward our Together in Mission goal this year. Thank you all for your welcome to Deacon Scott. Next weekend is Super Bowl Sunday (be sure to set aside time for Mass!) and the following weekend February 12th and 13th, I will assist at all the Masses with the Together in Mission pledge process. Thank you for all your faith and support!

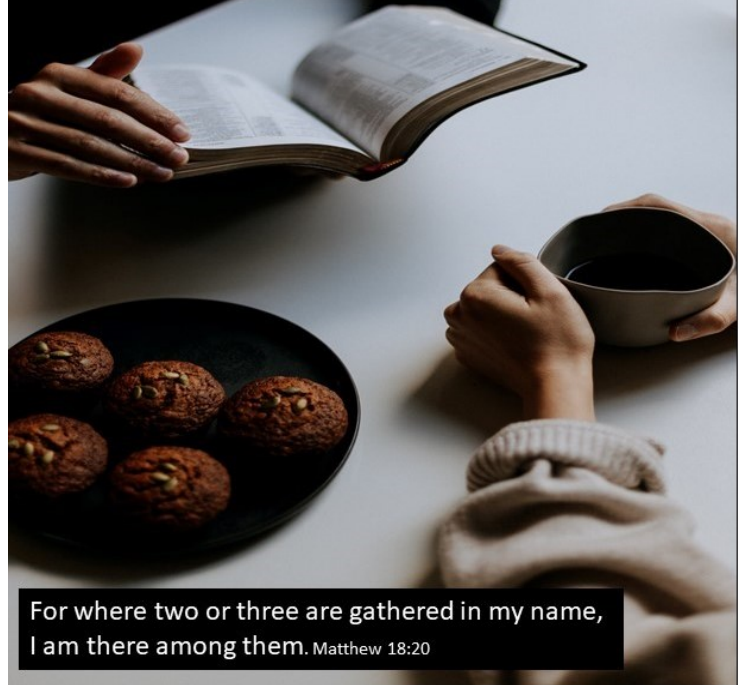

GOSPEL READING

Luke 5: 1-11

The fishermen (Simon, James, and John) leave their fishing boats and follow Jesus.

In What Ways do we Share in the Mission of the Church and Lead People to Christ?

In the people whom Jesus chose to be his closest friends—his disciples—we see many of the characteristic foibles of ordinary human beings. We also see the ways that God uses the gifts he gave us to transform us into new people, the agents through whom God will lead others to Jesus and to his kingdom. Let's consider the person Jesus chose to be a leader among the disciples and whom he sent to "catch people." Based on the evidence found in Scripture, we can imagine what Peter must have been like:

- Peter seems unafraid to speak his mind, yet he is also able to take direction. In today's Gospel, Simon Peter lowers his nets as Jesus commands, but not before reminding Jesus that he and his partners have been fishing all night and haven't caught anything.
- Peter's personality and charisma seem to make him the center of attention; yet Peter learned to be transparent, to let others see Jesus through him.
- Peter possesses a dynamic and open relationship with Jesus. Peter often approaches Jesus and speaks what is in his heart. Jesus chose Simon Peter to be the leader of the disciples. Peter continued to be a leader in the early Christian community; we continue to speak of Peter's leadership when we call the pope the successor of Peter. In what ways do we participate in the mission of the Church by leading people to Christ ("catching people")? Pray for those who lead the Church.

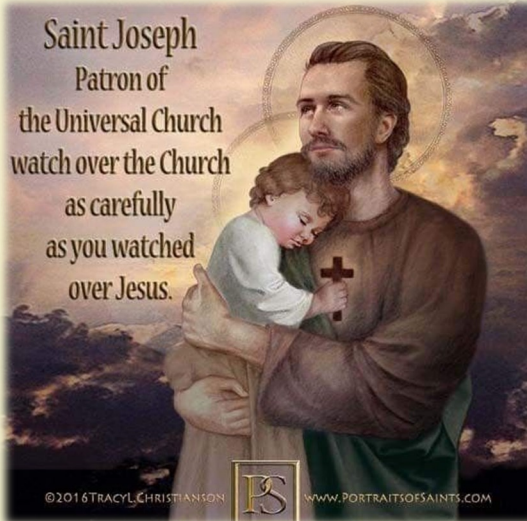
