Below please find the insert of the recent message from the Archdiocese. Thank you for your generosity. In these days, we are truly mindful of the words we pray at Mass after the Lord's Prayer: "Deliver us Lord from every evil, and grant us peace in our days..."

Given the recent events in Ukraine and the devastation that our brothers and sisters have had to face with the uncertainties in their country that has been ongoing since last month, and while over three million Ukrainians have fled their homes from the ongoing fighting into nearby countries, and over two thousand lives have been lost and thousands more inured, we are asking for your help.

During this time, Ukraine is in solemn need of our prayers and support as they face such devastating loss and tragedy within their country. Pope Francis tells us, "In God, no act of love, no matter how small, and no 'generous effort' will ever be lost." Pope Francis has encouraged help for the people of Ukraine.

In solidarity with our suffering brothers and sisters, Archbishop Gomez has asked all parishes to conduct a non-mandatory special collection March 19th and 20th. 


Cards of Hope for Easter!
