



Happy Spring! The arrival of Spring during our Lenten Season is no coincidence. The word Lent comes from a word meaning "springtime". This season of the year moves from the dormancy of Winter to the new life of Spring.

Spring is a time of renewal, a time to pull out the weeds and cut away the dead bush making room for the growth of new life. Similarly, Lent is a time of spiritual renewal and growth, a type of "spiritual spring." Often our faith life becomes dormant or stagnant like Winter. The prayers and fasting and acts of kindness and generosity that we adhere to during Lent, helps us to grow in our faith and gives us new life, reminding us - so whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come - 2 Corinthians 5:17. As we progress through our Lenten journey, the "springtime" in our Liturgical cycle, remember to:

- * Fast
- * Pray spend time daily with Jesus. attend daily Mass and or pray as you go.
- * Make time for family meals and prayer together.
- * Give be intentional; give your time, talent, and treasure to the poor.
- * Participate in the Stations of the Cross on Fridays.
- * Heal the hurts with in you and those that you have hurt.

Whether you choose from the seedlings above or create your own list of seeds which you plant, whatever you do during this time should help you grow in your faith and blossom for others to admire and emulate in love.

Give attention to the spiritual seedlings so that you may have a "springtime" in your spiritual life.



The forgiveness of the father in the parable is an image of God's love for us, generous beyond measure in his love for both of his sons. Can we truly believe that God acts this way towards us and accept his mercy without jealousy, knowing that God's love for another does not diminish his love for us? As you gather as a family, talk about why the older brother is jealous of the younger brother. Identify words that the family members in the parable might say to one another to begin to heal their broken relationships.
