



Earthquake Preparedness Basics

- * Have a "grab and go" bag ready with essential medications, water for each family member and/or pet, and a change of clothing for approximately 3 days.
- * Include a battery-operated radio and flashlight, ensuring that the batteries are working.
- * A thumb drive with copies of essential documents,
- * And, a first aid kit is a must!

Additionally, have a plan that is discussed with the family of where to meet when it happens. Preparation minimizes the stress of change. So be prepared!

GOSPEL READING

Luke 12:49-53

Jesus has come not only to bring peace but also division.

In the Long Run, Doing the Right Thing will Bring About a Deeper Unity

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says that he has come to bring division and that members of households will be divided.

Talk as a family about the things that you do together to bring about family unity, such as sharing meals, going to church together, celebrating special occasions, or sharing family traditions. Explain that all these things are important, and that Jesus wants families to show this kind of love for one another. In this Sunday's Gospel it sounds as though Jesus is saying something very different.

Explain that sometimes as parents, you make decisions that are unpopular with your children. You don't do it to divide the family but because it is the right thing to do. In the short run, such decisions may "divide" children from their parents. In the long run, however, doing the right thing will bring about a deeper unity. Talk to your children about decisions that they make that might be unpopular with their friends and how these decisions may divide them from others.




