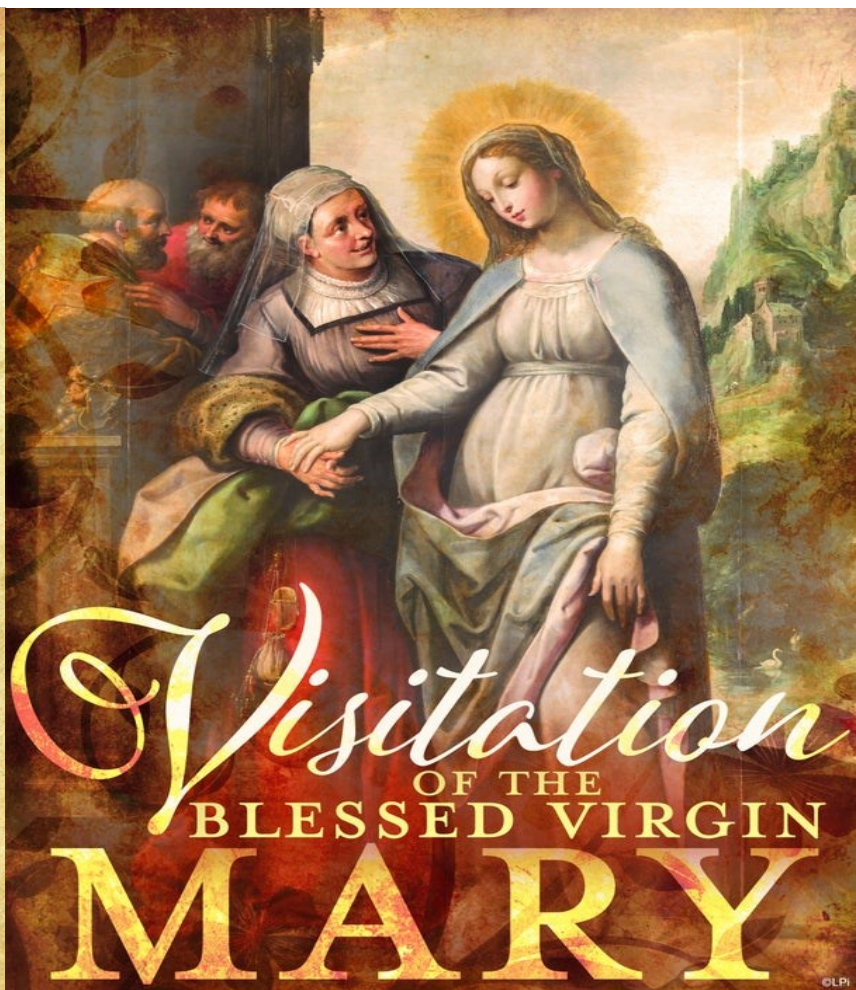

The Pastor's Post

FR. VAUGHN WINTERS



Dear Parish Family,

In our Gospel today Jesus speaks of peace, saying twice that we receive peace from him: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you". He adds a very important detail: "Not as the world gives do I give it to you". Sometimes we can think of peace simply as an absence of conflict: if a family is not squabbling or fighting, they are at peace. If two nations are not at war, they are at peace. We may think of ourselves as feeling peace for fleeting moments when everything seems to be going well in our lives and with our loved ones, and we have no big problems to contend with. Such moments are likely very few and far between, if they ever occur at all! The peace Jesus speaks of goes deeper than that. We should not allow the problems and challenges of life and this world to affect the peace we have in Christ. The Peace of Christ should abide with us and remain even as we navigate life's difficulties. If we know Jesus is present with us and loves us, and will guide us through this pilgrimage to His Heavenly Kingdom, the troubles of life should not detract from the deeper peace that we have. This is why Jesus adds the words "Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." What great advice! And yes, easier said than done, but possible when we strive to nurture our faith and trust in the Lord. In our readings at Mass the last couple weeks we have been hearing about the activity and trials of the Apostles in the Acts of the Apostles as they struggle to build up the Early Church. In the midst of the struggles and persecutions, they still had this lasting joy and peace of Christ - nothing and no one could deter them from their mission. We need to face our own problems with similar resolution and inner peace and strength.

We have a great help for this in the Holy Eucharist. Note that the words of Jesus' gift of peace occur in every Mass, after we pray the Lord's Prayer and as a prelude to the Sign of Peace and Holy Communion. Jesus gives us the Eucharist as a means to find peace. The Eucharist is the effective sign of unity and peace in our lives and in the Church. The Eucharist enables us to feel Christ's peace and also live in peace with each other. This Sunday we should reflect on this and how it applies to our own lives, and how we can more effectively allow the peace we have in Christ to deflect and overpower life's and the world's problems, which can be tools of the Evil One to rob us of our peace that Jesus desires to always abide in! He gives us peace; he leaves us peace - let's always accept and preserve within us this gift.

Did You Know?

May 24-25 || Age-appropriate curiosity in school-aged children

Last week, we covered young children and natural curiosity about their bodies. This week, we will explore natural curiosity behaviors in school-aged children (around 7-12 years old). It's important to understand the difference between appropriate and inappropriate, as inappropriate behaviors could be a sign of abuse. Common curiosity at this age includes playing games with same-aged friends like "family" or "dating," or wanting privacy. Children at these ages may also begin to take an interest in members of the opposite sex and ask questions about relationships.
