

Hello to All!

It's hard to believe that one year has passed since my ordination to the priesthood. I recently watched my First Mass which took place here at Saint Kateri on June 1st and was just as emotional as when it happened. I could not have asked for a better experience for my first time celebrating Mass. I'm still overwhelmed by the support and prayers of this community. I want to thank Fr. Vaughn for giving me this opportunity to share with you some of my thoughts and experiences this past year.

I have particularly enjoyed spending time getting to know so many of you. Whether it is the few moments we have together after Mass out on the plaza, appointments in the office, sharing meals, blessing houses or just walking around the parish grounds, I always appreciate the time we get to spend together.

An especially powerful moment for me during this year happened this past March. As many of you know, since many of you were there. Pope Francis asked the Church to hold a time of 24 hours dedicated to adoration and confessions. This took place throughout the world on March 28-29. Even from 1:00am to 3:30am, people were lined up out the door and waiting hours to reconcile with our Lord. In those few short hours, I probably heard close to 80 confessions. There were people praying and singing in the Church. So many people waited so long for confession, many coming back to the sacrament after 15, 20, even 30 years. To be in persona Christi, that is to be in the person of Christ, acting as his instrument, not just in that moment, but every time I sit in the confessional is a humbling and inspiring experience.

All I can say is that I am so glad that God and the Archbishop chose Saint Kateri as my first assignment. I absolutely love the priesthood and too all the young men who might be reading this, I cannot recommend strongly enough the joy, the peace, the true happiness that I have found in this vocation. Maybe God is

calling you?

Please continue to pray for me, pray for all your priests and those discerning this life. You are all in my prayers and I can't wait to see what's in store for my second year. May the Risen Christ continue to be your Hope and Our Blessed Mother, your guide!
