



Dear Parish Family,

Today is a day of great joy as we celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving for Father Michael Croghan, our former seminarian intern, who was ordained with seven other new priests for our Archdiocese on Saturday, May 3, at Our Lady Queen of Angels Cathedral! We are so blessed to have had our newly ordained Associate Pastor Fr. Jihoon Kim with us as his first parish assignment 2021-2024, then two years ago celebrating the First Mass of Fr. Emmanuel Sanchez, followed by last year's First Mass for our Associate Pastor, Fr. Stephen Watson, and now here we are for Fr. Michael! I concelebrated last week Fr. Michael's actual "First Mass" at his home parish of Good Shepherd, Beverly Hills, and we are honored to have him here with us for his second Sunday of his priesthood! Fr. Michael is from Santa Cruz and decided to adopt Southern California as his home, and was put in touch with Father Ed Benioff, pastor of Good Shepherd, who accepted him as his seminarian. The community of Good Shepherd was happy to adopt Fr. Michael as he made his journey to priesthood. And of course we were privileged to have him with us for one year as our intern, where he got to experience the realities and joys of daily parish life. As you are presently doing with Thomas, our parish community served as teachers and sources of guidance and inspiration for Fr. Michael in his year with us.

In his homily, Archbishop Jose Gomez mentioned how our newly ordained priests are a great sign of hope. He invoked the example of Pope Leo XIV who served for many years as a missionary priest and bishop in Peru, and called upon the new priests to have that same missionary spirit. "They have left behind their old lives to follow him and to be fathers and priests for his people. My brothers, Like St. Augustine, like St. Paul, like every priest before you: you can choose Jesus today, because he has chosen you first. You can love, because Jesus loved you first. You are called to open wide the doors of your churches and to go out and bring Jesus to your neighbors, to their families, to their children, to the poor and the lost." A very moving part of Fr. Michael's First Mass was when he acknowledged the presence on the altar of Msgr. Colm O'Ryan, Pastor Emeritus of Good Shepherd Church, who is 96 years old and has been ordained a priest for 70 years! Fr. Michael and Msgr. O'Ryan had grown very close over the years and Monsignor suffered a setback just last week and was in the hospital. Fr. Michael said: "Msgr. O'Ryan, you asked God to be able to be present at my First Mass, and God granted your prayer and you were able to keep your promise - here you are!" God Bless you, Fr Michael. The Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Parish Family is filled with joy and gratitude to have been part of your journey to the altar of the Lord, and we look forward to sharing with you in your life of service that lies ahead!
