

Dear Saint Kateri Community,

This is your friendly neighbor seminarian, Thomas. It has been 10 months since I arrived at Saint Kateri last August. Time flies. My last day here at Saint Kateri is June 13th, 2025. However, I asked Fr. Vaughn to extend my internship two weeks to run Teens on a Mission, so my last day at Saint Kateri is Sunday, June 29th, 2025. I will return to the seminary for studying for about three semesters, and then, I will be ordained as a deacon and sent to a parish for six months. God willing, in two years, in June 2027, I will come back to Saint Kateri to celebrate my Thanksgiving Mass as Fr. Michael Croghan did last week.

I would like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude toward all of you, the parishioners at Saint Kateri. This year has been a blessing for me with all the positive experiences with the ministry and all of you. You have welcomed me with a warm heart and let me be a part of your big family. The community at Saint Kateri and Fr. Vaughn have formed me tremendously to become a better seminarian and better priest in the future. When I leave here, I will greatly miss the conversation, with each one of you after Mass, the discussion about God in the Women's Bible Study and the Men's Group, the sharing with the youth in Confirmation, Religious Education class, OCIA, and Legion of Mary, and serving our friends in the street with Bridge to Home and Skid Row ministries. Many other ministries in the community also helped me to grow immensely to the heart of Jesus Christ.

Priesthood is not an easy journey at all. I told the quote of Saint John Vianney many times, but I would like to share it again, If the priest is saintly, the people will be holy. If the priest is holy, the people will be good. If the priest is good, the people will be godless." Becoming a saintly priest is a difficult journey, which includes the daily fight with the devil, the flesh, and the world by constant mortification. I don't want to be the mediocre priest or just a good priest, but a saintly priest who brings more souls back to God. Thanks be to God that I have a good example of Fr. Vaughn this year as my mentor to teach and guide me to be a saintly priest for the Lord.

Lastly, I would like to ask for your prayers. This year, I experienced greatly the power of the interceding prayer. When I felt discouraged or did not know how to deal with the problem, immediately I felt great calm and peace from God. At that moment, I know that someone is praying for me right now to ask God's grace upon me. I need your prayers. The journey of the priesthood is not easy, interceding prayer is the powerful weapon against the devil and temptation. Please continue to pray for me and for your priests. Thank you so much for your prayers and support.





## Did You Know?

June 14-15 || Body safety information for young children



Children should know the difference between "okay" and "not okay" or "good" and "bad" touches – touches that are welcome and comforting, and those that are intrusive, unwanted, painful, or uncomfortable. Children should know that they have the right to say "no" to being touched, even to adults, and that no children or adults should touch their private parts unless in very specific circumstances, and for a healthy purpose. This is where it can be helpful to discuss "safe adults," like doctors, who check our bodies to help keep us healthy, and only in the presence of a parent or trusted adult.
