

Dear Parish Family,

Last week I was at the campus of Villanova Preparatory High School all week which hosts the annual five-day Camp Big Deal, a Catholic leadership camp for kids entering the 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. The Camp began in 1989 with the vision of Dennis Santos, the youth minister at the time of St. Raphael Church in Santa Barbara. Teresa McIntosh our Youth Minister and six kids from our parish were there. The Camp combines games and fun, activities working together in groups, and faith formation, talks, and daily Mass, confessions and other prayer experiences. Dennis Santos had attended a Christian Jr. High Camp and was very impressed by it, except he noticed there was one crucial thing missing: the Eucharist. He approached the Regional Bishop about starting the camp and received the go-ahead to assemble a team; as a seminarian I was actually a part of the very first one. Four years later I was assigned to Dennis' parish of St. Raphael's as my first parish assignment as a newly-ordained priest, so a lifetime (so far) of association with these camps was formed. I've also assisted with a five day program for kids who've just received Confirmation, called "Signed, Anointed, to Witness". Even though I've moved on to other parishes, I have continued to help with these programs and invited young people from my parish to go. It's been an amazing journey to see the programs evolve, venues change, and different team leaders come and go, but the camps keep going and make a difference in the lives of faith of the young participants.

I shared with the young participants at the closing Mass how if they allow the Holy Spirit to work in their lives, it is amazing what God can now and in the future accomplish through them, thinking of all the fruit of the efforts of one youth minister who had an idea 36 years ago. Recently the camps' existence were threatened by funding issues but the priests and staff, of Villanova Prep stepped in and, along the support of myself and our other team leaders, were able to commit to keep Camp Big Deal and Signed, Anointed, to Witness going. It is wonderful have the support of Villianova Prep and the Augustinian priests there. Since they are brother Augustinians, they all personally know Pope Leo! Think of any young people in your lives who could benefit from being at these camps next year, and remember the powerful things that can happen when we are open to the Spirit working in our lives.




